Attach Request Narrative Credit Change from 40 to 45 credits: The counseling program is in the process of evaluating the number of credits required to complete the program. National standards (CACREP) require 48 credits for a school counseling program. Currently UWRF counseling program requires 40 credits to graduate. More than half of our students no longer have a background in education, therefore, they are required to take "elective" 6 credits to meet DPI requirements. These students end up with 42 credits upon graduation. Other students are encouraged to take COUN 770, leaving them with one elective credit. In order to provide opportunity for more elective credits, and to draw our program closer in line with national standards, we are requesting a move to 45 credits to graduate beginning in Fall 2011.
