Whereas, the 2007 Higher Education Tax Credit Bill aims to keep the Wisconsin economy strong by growing local business, creating more skilled employees, and providing higher paying jobs through a 50% tax credit toward businesses who are sending employees back to school, and a 75% cut if that employee has a taxable income of less than 185% of the federal poverty line.

And whereas, a competitive Wisconsin economy is beneficial to the students of UAW-RF, who are the future workforce of Wisconsin.

Be it resolved that, the UW-RF Student Association Student Senate take a stance in support of the 2007 Higher Education Tax Credit Bill.
