



**ANOKA-RAMSEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
COURSE EQUIVALENCY TABLE  
(2007-08 ARCC CATALOG/2007-09 UW-RF CATALOG)**

This course equivalency table is intended as a guide for program planning at Anoka-Ramsey Comm. College and may be subject to change.

Academic advisement at UW-River Falls is provided by the major department. Course substitutions in the major or minor fields must be approved by the major or minor department chair. Course substitutions outside the major or minor (such as General Education, teacher certification requirements, liberal arts requirements) must be approved by the Dean of the College certifying the degree (College of Education, College of Arts & Sciences, College of Agriculture, Food & Environmental Sciences, or College of Business & Economics).

A maximum of 72 semester credits may be accepted in total from two-year colleges. Students who have attended two-year colleges must complete a minimum of 60 semester credits at four-year baccalaureate degree granting institutions. At least 30 semester credits must be earned at UW-River Falls to be granted a degree by UW-River Falls, including at least 6 semester credits in the major area and 3 semester credits in the minor area. The final credits must be earned at UW-River Falls. A total of 120 to 128 semester credits are required in most degree programs at UW-River Falls.

The Associate of Arts degree at Anoka-Ramsey is considered to satisfy UW-RF General Education requirements, except for the Senior Interdisciplinary Capstone Course, which must be taken in the senior year at UW-RF. It may be necessary, however, to take courses to meet specific program requirements, to meet prerequisites for advanced courses or to satisfy state teacher certification requirements. To qualify for the Associate Degree/General Education policy, the AA degree must be earned prior to initial enrollment at UW-RF. Career oriented associate degrees, associate of applied science degrees, or other similar associate degree programs do not satisfy General Education requirements. Students with questions about associate degree policies may contact the UW-RF Admissions Office.

For students who do not anticipate completing an Associate of Arts degree, General Education plan sheets have been developed to assist students in course selection. See ARCC counselors, the UW-RF Website ([www.uwrf.edu](http://www.uwrf.edu)) or contact the UW-RF Admissions Office. **STUDENTS CONSIDERING TRANSFER IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION, SECONDARY EDUCATION, SOCIAL WORK, OR AGRICULTURE MAJORS ARE URGED TO CONSIDER TRANSFER AFTER ONLY TWO OR THREE SEMESTERS AT ANOKA-RAMSEY.**

**Elementary Education enrollment is limited.** The Elem Ed application priority date is October 1, with a minimum 3.0 GPA required. Application priority for other majors is February 1. Applications are considered beyond the priority dates until enrollment targets are met. **Secondary education applicants** need a minimum 2.75 GPA. Priority for other majors is a 2.6 GPA. Students with GPA between 2.0 and 2.6 (3.0 if Elem Ed, or 2.75 if secondary ed) are considered on a space available basis. **Limits may be placed** on other majors if needed to stay within program capacity. Consult the UW-RF Admissions Office for current information. **Priority consideration** may be given to students who have completed the English Composition, Speech, Mathematics and Science requirements. **Transfer after one year is recommended** for teacher education, agriculture, and social work students.
