This course equivalency table is intended as a guide for program planning at Normandale Community College and may be subject to change.

Academic advisement at UW-River Falls is provided by the major department. Course substitutions in the major or minor fields must be approved by the major or minor department chair. Course substitutions outside the major or minor (such as General Education, teacher certification requirements, liberal arts requirements) must be approved by the Dean of the College certifying the degree (College of Education & Professional Studies, College of Arts & Sciences, College of Agriculture, Food & Environmental Sciences or College of Business & Economics).

A maximum of 72 semester credits may be accepted in total from two-year colleges. To be awarded a degree by UW-River Falls, transfer students must meet graduation requirements and complete at least 30 semester credits at UW-River Falls, including at least 6 semester credits in the major area and 3 semester credits in the minor area, with additional credits determined by the major department. The final 15 credits must be earned at UW-River Falls. Most degree programs require a total of 120 to 128 semester credits.

The Associate of Arts degree at Normandale is considered to satisfy UW-River Falls General Education requirements, except for an upper level Multidisciplinary Inquiry course. It may be necessary, however, to take courses to meet specific program requirements, to meet prerequisites for advanced courses, or to satisfy professional licensure requirements in areas such as teacher education or social work. To qualify for the Associate Degree/General Education policy, the AA degree must be earned prior to initial enrollment at UW-River Falls. Career oriented associate degrees, associate of applied science degrees, or other similar associate degree programs do not satisfy General Education requirements. Students with questions about associate degree policies may contact the UWRF Admissions Office.

Students who do not anticipate completing an Associate of Arts degree should consult the UWRF General Education plan sheet for Normandale.
