COURSE TRANSFER INFORMATION**

Saint Paul College (SPC) liberal arts courses which have been reviewed and approved by the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnSCU) System for transfer within the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) will be considered for transfer to the University of Wisconsin-River Falls (UWRF). Other SPC courses may be considered for transfer where related to areas of study offered at UWRF. Courses of a vocational/technical nature do not routinely transfer.
