## Mock Interview Questions

1. Tell me about yourself.
2. Why did you choose the career for which you are preparing?
3. Describe the most difficult project you have had to complete for school, work, or for an internship.
4. Tell me what you would consider to be your three greatest strengths, or positive attributes.
5. Tell me about the last time you were criticized by a supervisor or a professor. Did you believe the criticism was valid, and how did you handle the situation?
6. If you were hiring a college graduate for this (hypothetical) position, upon which qualities, skills, and experience would you base your decision?
7. If I called a former employer to ask for feedback about you and your performance on the job, what would he or she have to say about you?
8. Tell me about your experience with diversity; i.e., working with individuals from ethnic backgrounds that differ from your own. How would you handle a situation where there was a communication barrier that existed between yourself and another colleague or customer?
9. Consider the following scenario: your supervisor left an assignment in your "in box" and then left town for a week. You can't reach him or her, and don't fully understand the assignment. What would you do?
10. If you were chosen to lead a group, what actions would you take to develop teamwork? In general, how do you function as a team member?
11. Describe an idea or a project you generated on your own.
12. How do you manage change?
13. Tell me what you would consider to be your three greatest weaknesses.
14. Tell me about a situation in when you had to resolve a conflict with someone with whom it was difficult to work. What were some techniques in resolving the conflict, and what was the outcome of the situation?
