The Chancellor is the highest administrative position on the UWRF campus, and reports directly to the president of the University of Wisconsin System. The role of the Chancellor is increasingly focused on activities beyond the day-to-day operations of the campus. For example, as the funding from the state declines as a percentage of the total, the Chancellor must develop relationships with other sources to ensure UWRF has the resources to carry out its mission and vision. The Chancellor is responsible for the allocation of resources on campus, and ultimately sets budget priorities. This is done in conjunction with faculty and students in areas that are covered by the shared governance statutes in Wisconsin law.
