  - 2) Sustainable Agriculture Emphasis within the Crop and Soil Science major (Holleran, May). Proposed addition of a third emphasis to the Crop and Soil Science major. Will resubmit to include AGED 270 as an internship option, forced prerequisites, and consultation with departments beyond CAFES to monitor impact on course selections. Motion passed unanimously.
