Chair's Report:

Old Business:

1. P ED371 Recreational Field Study (returned to the table from 9/22/06 motion to table) J. Tangen-Foster - Proposal to allow students to retake the course for up to 8 credits, unprecedented with other internship courses on campus. The explanation was offered that students could apply it to multiple experiences and settings and substitute it for similar required elective credits. Y. Dutton said that the DAR category that it is in would allow students to take fewer credits to complete the requirements listed in the category if students were to substitute the variable P ED371 credits for the others. There was no objection to approval of the number of credits in general, but that maybe P ED371 should have a category of its own on the DAR. This will be handled through consultation of the DAR coordinator and HHP Dept. Motion to approve the request to retake the course for as many as 8 credits was approved unanimously.

2. Reviewing the changes in By-Law language regarding University Curriculum Committee
L. McCann presented proposed changes to the UCC By-Laws (Chapter 3.3, Article III, Section F. Suggestions for consistency: the term "college curriculum committee" would be written in lower case since it referred to any of the college curriculum committees. Motion to recommend changes to the Faculty Senate (M.Clifford, L. Jermal) passed unanimously.

3. Review and revision of the course approval documents and transmittal forms was postponed until the next meeting.

New Business:

1. WMST/PSYC225 Sex Differences, Gender Roles, and Sexual Orientation (motion to receive, review and record - T. Buttles, L. Jermal) B. Caskey - Change of course title and catalog description to reflect current terminology. Motion passed unanimously.

2. PLP772 Internship, Seminar, and Individual Project II. (motion to receive, review and record - T. Buttles, M. Clifford) F. Monsour - change in catalog description to reflect the updated delivery of the course. Approval after adding pre-requisites to catalog description and correcting typos in #5 (320 hrs.) and parentheses in #6 on proposal form. Motion passed unanimously.

3. PHYS220 Science of Light (motion to receive, review and record - M. Clifford, L. Jermal) L. McCann - Change of credits from 4 to 3 to make it more manageable as a liberal arts science elective. No change in content, only in the time spent on activities. Motion passed unanimously

T. Buttles moved and M. Clifford seconded to adjourn the meeting at 4:30. The motion passed.
