1. K-12 Curriculum for School Counselors, a required course for all counseling students who are not licensed teachers, was designated as COUN 781:3 (old course number).
2. There are other seminar courses, COUN 781: 2 and COUN 781:4, which are a required part of the practicum experience.
3. Students continued to be confused when signing up for courses, often times signing up for Practicum Seminar instead of K-12 Curriculum, etc..
4. As a program we decided to change the designation for K-12 Curriculum for School Counselors to COUN 770 in an effort to alleviate confusion for students.
5. After review and approval by Lowell McCann, 2008 Curriculum Committee chair, he determined that the course number change to COUN 770 constituted a minor change to the program that AP&P must approve.

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


