The Financial Assistance Office will determine any additional eligibility for financial aid for participating in a study abroad program. **Completing this form does not guarantee that you will qualify for additional financial assistance or that financial assistance will cover the cost of the program.** You must have a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the academic year of the study abroad program to be eligible for any federal or state financial assistance. Wisconsin residents will be considered for the Wisconsin Study Abroad Grant.

The Financial Assistance Office will receive a detail of expenses for the study abroad program from the Global Connections Office.

A Notification of Arrival form provided by the Global Connections Office is used to confirm enrollment. The Global Connections Office will forward a copy of your completed Notification of Arrival to the Financial Assistance Office so that your financial aid can be disbursed.

IMPORTANT:

Financial aid cannot be disbursed prior to the beginning of the semester in which you are studying abroad. If you have program costs that are due prior to the semester that funds can be disbursed by financial aid, you will be responsible for making arrangements to pay any up-front costs.
