The Game

UW-River Falls plays its third, and final, non-conference game of the 2009 season on Saturday when they host Alma College. UWRF enters the game with a 1-1 record. They picked up a road win last weekend, winning 20-17, at Northwestern College. The Scots are 2-1 overall. This will be their third road game this year and they are 2-0 away from home. Last weekend they won at Rockford, 51-3.

The Coaches

UWRF's John O'Grady is in his 21st season with the Falcons. He has a 102-97-3 overall record at UWRF. He is 72-68-3 in WIAC games and is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and was the team's captain in 1975 and played linebacker. O'Grady was inducted into the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2008. He is 2-0 all-time against Alma College. Jim Cole is in his 18th season at Alma. He has a 107-68 career record with the Scots and his the school's winningest football coach. He is a 1974 graduate of Alma and was a quarterback for the team in the early 1970s.

The Falcons

The Falcons go for their second straight win on Saturday when they host Alma. In two games the Falcons have utilized a balanced offensive attack. The Falcons have rushed for 362 yards and passed for 375 in the two games played. Junior running back Ahmad Palmer leads the Falcon rushing attack with with 154 yards. He averages a healthy five yards per carry and has scored once. Junior quarterback Ryan Luessenheidi has played two solid games in his first two collegiate starts. He has completed 28-43 passes for 375 yards and two touchdowns. He has thrown one interception. He has taken advantage of a couple of big targets in senior tight end Ryan Hansen and sophomore wide receiver Michael Woodward. Both have nine catches to lead the team. Hansen has 170 receiving yards and Woodward 113. The Falcon defense has played well against the run allowing just 234 rushing yards. Senior linebackers Cole Lowell (7-11-18) and Justin Eloranta (4-11-15) lead the team in tackles. The Falcons

have come up with six sacks, one interception (Curtis Johnson) and one fumble recovery (Derrick Bender). Seven Falcons have registered a sack.

1979, 1984 Teams Recognized

On Saturday the Falcons will recognize two championship teams at halftime. Invited back are all members of the 1979 and 1984 teams. The 1979 team was the first UWRF football team to qualify for post-season play. After finishing the regular season 9-1, the Falcons played San Angelo State in the first round of the NAIA Div. I playoffs. The Falcons lost the game, 31-7. The 1984 Falcons won the WIAC championship and finished 8-2 overall. Both teams were coached by Mike Farley.

The Scots

Alma College is looking to keep playing well on the road on Saturday. The Scots rely on the passing game to score points. The average less than 100 yards a game rushing, but average nearly 300 yards per game passing. Quarterback Mackenzie McGrady has completed 63-120 passes for 850 yards and nine touchdowns. He has thrown six picks. After the team's 51-3 win at Rockford, McGrady was named the MIAA Player of the Week for the second time this year. Andrew Schaar leads the team with 18 catches for 273 yards and two scores. Tyler Wise has three catches for 190 yards and two touchdowns. The Scots defense is led by Conrad Bovee (18-14-32) and Brent Willis (13-15-28) who lead the team in tackles. Willis leads the team in tackles for loss with five. Kyle Short has the team's one interception. The Alma defense allows 126 rushing and 150 passing yards a game.

Up Next For The Falcons

The Falcons will open WIAC play on Oct. 3 when they travel to UW-Stout. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m., at Nelson Field. The Blue Devils were picked to finish fifth, and the Falcons were picked for seventh, in the annual WIAC Sports Information Directors pre-season poll.

The Falcons are 31-44 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-20 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome in Minneapolis, Minn., 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UWRF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 482-330-49 record in 105 seasons.
