The Falcon Basketball Camps will be held at the River Falls High School Gymnasium. The High School Facility is a great basketball camp facility with its wood floor, multiple baskets, and air-conditioning. The River Falls High School is located on Cemetery Road, which is located on the south side of River Falls connecting state roads 29/35 and 65 that run through River Falls. This will be the 19th summer of basketball camps at UW-River Falls under Head Coach Rick Bowen, the all-time winningest coach in UW-RF history. Coach Bowen also coached at the Division I level - University of Wisconsin and Ball State University and was a high school basketball coach in his native state of Indiana for 12 years. Jeff Berkhof, his assistant coach for eleven seasons, will run the day to day operations of camp. Coach Berkhof has worked many basketball camps in the Midwest and was an all-conference performer for the Falcons in 1993-94.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

Dates: June 14-17 Fee: \$145 Grades: 7-9 (Fall '05) Time: Noon-5: 30 pm

The Skill Development camp is designed for personalized instruction covering all phases of skill improvement. Each session will include teaching stations that will consist of repetitive skill work with proper technique and footwork being emphasized. The skill stations will be broken down into shooting, position breakdown, and defensive stations. Each day of camp will include two 5-on-5 full court games with campers receiving equal playing time. Team play, game situations, and the ability to compete against the area's best young players will be available for each camper's self-improvement. Each day will include a break in the middle of the session where we will provide drink and a small snack.

The Youth Day Camp is designed to teach the basic fundamentals and skills of basketball. Learning and having fun will be stressed each day of camp. Each session will include teaching stations that focus on dribbling, passing, and shooting, with emphasis on proper technique and footwork. Also, each session will include team skill contests where teams will compete against one another while working on their skill development. Each day of camp will include two 5 on 5 league games where each camper will receive equal playing time and will be divided by age and ability. Each day will include a break in the middle of the session where we will provide drink and a small snack.
