The Games

-The Falcons play two road WIAC games this week against teams that garnered all of the first place votes in the conference pre-season poll. The Falcons first play at UW-Stout on Wednesday and then travel to UW-Oshkosh on Saturday. UWO earned seven first place votes and UWS earned the other in the pre-season poll.

-UWRF lost a 76-65 WIAC decision to UW-Whitewater at the Karges Center on Saturday. The Falcons will be looking to snap a three game losing streak. Hans Hoeg leads the Falcons in scoring (16.2) and rebounding (4.8). The Falcons are 23-15 against UW-Stout and 12-28 against UW-Oshkosh in Coach Rick Bowen's tenure.

-UWS features three 7-footers, and another who is 6-10, on its roster. Stout won 10 straight games, but have since lost two WIAC games in a row. They lost at UW-Stevens Point (89-84) on Saturday in two overtimes. Ryan Stangl leads four players who score in double figures - he averages 12.7.

-UWO returns a veteran lineup for the 2005-06 season. Ten letter winners are back from the 2005 team that finished 19-8. The Titans are riding a four-game winning streak (they host La Crosse on Wednesday). Three of the four wins came on the road. Three Titans average in double figures in scoring led by Andy Jahnke who scores 15 points a game. Kerry Gibson averages 7.4 rebounds a game.

River Falls - Previous Week Recap

The Falcons lost a 76-65 WIAC decision to UW-Whitewater at the Karges Center on Saturday. Ryan Zylstra led the Falcons with a career high 22 points and nine rebounds. Hans Hoeg scored 14 points and had five rebounds and three assists. Ryan Thompson led the Falcons with six assists. UWW had four players score in double figures led by Jeremy Manchester who scored 22. He was 8-16 from the field, including 6-8 from three-point range. Andy Freund led the Warhawks with seven rebounds.

Head Coach - Rick Bowen

Rick Bowen begins his 20th season as the UW-River Falls basketball coach in 2005-06.

He will be the first to admit that his lengthy tenure surprises him as much as anybody. "I originally came here thinking I would stay a maximum of five years and move on, but the University and the community have been so good to me that it has just turned into 20 years.

"This is a very special place. I am allowed to teach and coach. I am allowed to live a life doing what I love to do. The University administration has its priorities in order. I have really come to respect basketball at the Div. III level. To have the opportunity to coach basketball at the highest of levels in the WIAC and UW-River Falls is a privilege."

Bowen currently is seventh all time in the WIAC win column. His 259 victories at UW-River Falls put him first all-time in Falcon victories. Combining his head high school and collegiate wins, Bowen is approaching the 400 win total for his career.

The 2003-04 season will go down in history as the season that ended 54 years of Falcon basketball frustration. The Falcons hit the 20-win mark for the first time since the 1950 season and brought the elusive WIAC championship home to Karges Center, the campus and the city of River Falls. He was named the WIAC basketball Coach of the Year award and his peers also selected him as the NABC West Region Coach of the Year.

This was not the only national recognition Bowen and the Falcons received. The NABC named 6-8 Rich Melzer as the Div. III National Player of the Year and a first team All-American for the second consecutive year. Melzer is now playing professionally for a team in New Zealand in the Australian professional league.

Success has not come easy for Bowen and UW-River Falls. The 2005-06 season begins the 94th season of collegiate basketball for the Falcons. The University sports an overall 883-927 record for a .490 win/loss percentage. Bowen is currently 259-234. Since the turn of the new century the Falcons have been 89-52 finishing 1st, 3rd, 3rd, 4th and 5th in the nation's most competitive basketball conference.

The seven consecutive winning seasons from 1989 to 1996 was a stretch that was last equaled in the 1915-22 Falcon basketball seasons. Bowen's Falcons made school history for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th time by landing a spot in the NAIA District 14 playoffs in 1987, 1990, 1991 and 1992.

"I know we have struggled at times. I make no excuses. We are what we are. We play in Karges Center, a sub-par facility. We lack the historical perspective of some of our competitors. I have enjoyed taking the kids that want to come to River Falls to get a good education, and play basketball, and make us competitive. We have been consistently good, and I am very proud of that."

In the 2004-05 academic year Bowen's responsibilities increased as he was named the permanent UWRF Athletic Director, He is the only coach in the WIAC doing double duty serving as a coach and Director of Athletics.

Bowen came to UW-RF in 1986 following five years as a Wisconsin Badger assistant coach where he served on the staff with current Badger Coach Bo Ryan. He previously was an assistant coach at Ball State University, working under Coach Steve Yoder at both institutions.

Bowen graduated from Indiana University with an undergraduate degree in physical education in 1966. He served the Hoosiers as a student-manager under two time National Champion Coach Branch McCracken. Like his father, son Matthew was a basketball manager at Indiana University under Coach Bob Knight. Basketball runs deep in the Bowen family. Grandfather Vernie Bowen was an Indiana High School coach for 40 years. Nephew Christopher is currently the basketball manager at the United States Military Academy under Coach Jim Crews. Nephew Andrew Bowen is currently the basketball manager at Bethel College in Mishawaka, Indiana.

Bowen began his career in Indiana teaching government and coaching basketball. He earned a Masters degree from St. Francis in 1971. He served in the United States Army as a combat medic from 1967-69 with service in Vietnam from December of 1967 to December of 1968. For his actions in Vietnam he was awarded a Bronze Star.



Rick and his wife Sandy met as students while at Indiana University. They have been married for 39 years and have two sons. Sandy is retired after teaching cell biology and botany at River Falls High School. Matthew is assistant basketball coach at Valparaiso University and married to Birmingham, Ala., native Ashli. They have a daughter, McKenzi, 3, and reside in Valparaiso, Ind.



Mike and his wife Pam, a UWRF graduate in marketing communications and former Falcon tennis player from Monticello, Minn., own and operate Bowen's Garage on Main Street in River Falls. Pam also works in the Graduate and Outreach department at the University. Mike is a graduate of Dakota County Technical School.

UW-River Falls vs. UW-Stout -- Last Meeting

Stout 79, River Falls 71

The Falcon men's basketball team drew within two points with just under two minutes to play, but ended with a 79-71 loss to UW-Stout Wednesday night at the Karges Center.

UWRF trailed 30-19 at the half and by 15 points twice in the second half before mounting a comeback. Trailing 54-39 with 11:08 to play, the Falcons went on an 11-0 run to get to within 54-50 with 8:53 to play. The Falcons then got to within one, 57-56, with 6:24 to play when Eric Kossoris scored on a layup. UWS then scored six straight points to go ahead, 63-56 with 5:37 to play. Trailing by nine, 72-63, with 2:26 to play the Falcons went on another run, this one 7-0, to pull to within 72-70 with 1:55 to play. But the Blue Devils outscored the Falcons, 7-1, down the stretch.

UWRF was led by Jeff Holt who scored 18 points. Kossoris scored 16 and Hans Hoeg 12. Kossoris led the Falcons with five rebounds. UWRF shot 26-59 (.441) from the field, including 11-30 (.367) from three-point range. The Falcons were 8-11 (.727) from the line.

UWS was led by Jacob Nonemacher who came off the bench to score 16 points and grab seven rebounds. Ryan Stangl finished with 14 points. He hit three three-pointers down the stretch. UWS was 27-53 (.509) from the field, including 8-22 (.364) from behind the arc. The Blue Devils were 17-25 (.680) from the line. UWS held a 37-29 advantage in rebounds.

UW-River Falls vs. UW-Oshkosh -- Last Meeting

Oshkosh 65, River Falls 59

The River Falls men's basketball team (6-13, 2-9) fell to UW-Oshkosh (15-5, 8-3), 65-59, Saturday evening in the Karges Center.

River Falls held a 25-24 lead at halftime thanks to seven three pointers, four from senior forward Jeff Holt who led all scorers with 14 points at the break. The Falcons scored their first 21 points on threes and held an 18-10 lead with 9:06 to play in the first. The Titans responded with a 15-7 run to close the half and pull within one.

The second half went back and forth. River Falls went on an 8-2 run to hold their largest lead of the second half at 42-36 with 9:44 to play. UWO responded with an 11-0 run to take a 47-42 led with just under eight minutes left. Oshkosh hit 10-12 free throws in the final five minutes to secure the 65-59 victory.

For the game River Falls shot 18-55 (32.7) overall, 11-32 (34.4) from three point land and 12-16 (75.0) from the free throw line. Overall Oshkosh shot 22-48 (45.8) overall, 3-14 (21.4) from beyond the arc and 18-24 (75.0) from the line.

Oshkosh outscored RF in the paint 32-8. River Falls turned 12 Titan turnovers into 15 points while Oshkosh only scored five points off of seven Falcon turnovers. Second chance points were 19-6 in favor of UWO.

Individually Holt scored a game and career high 25 points. The only other Falcons in double figures were senior guard Dan Torrez with 11 points and sophomore guard Hans Hoeg with 12 points. Holt also led RF with seven rebounds and two blocks. Freshman forward Scott Kelly dished out a game high five assists.

Three Titans reached double digits in scoring. Jim Capelle led all with 16 points, Andy Jahnke put in 12 points and Kerry Gibson scored 11. Gibson also had a game high four blocks to go with eight rebounds. Jahnke grabbed a game high nine boards.
