It's Notable

* Week 2 has the Falcons playing both home and road games this weekend. The Falcons play their first of nine road games on Friday at St. Olaf. Saturday the Falcons return to Hunt Arena to host Gustavus Adolphus. Both teams are members of the MIAC and the games are part of the NCHA's cross over schedule with the MIAC. In all there are 16 games between NCHA and MIAC teams this weekend.

* Last year St. Olaf handed the Falcons one of its nine losses, and one of four home losses, with a 5-2 decision at Hunt Arena. SO led 2-1 after one period and 3-2 after two. SO goalie Jeff Wilde made 30 saves to get the win. The Oles have won two out of the last three games played between the teams. But the Falcons hold a 26-9-0 advantage in the all-time series. This is the first game of the season for SO.

* The Falcons and Gusties did not play last year. The teams last met in the 2003-04 season with the Falcons earning a 4-3 win at Hunt Arena. UW-RF has won five straight games over GAC and have a 17-12-2 lead in the series. The Gusties dominated the series early going 9-0-1 in the first 10 games between the two squads. Defenseman Keith Detlefsen was named to the Preseason All-USCHO Team. He led the Gusties in scoring last year (13-25-38).

Steve Freeman

Head Coach



Steve Freeman begins the 2005-06 season, his 10th as head coach, as the leader of one of the elite powerhouse programs in the nation.

Freeman received a sixth Coach of the Year award in 2005 - he was named the WIAC Coach of the Year for the fourth time in his career.

He is the winningest coach in UW-River Falls hockey history and that was accomplished in just six seasons. He became the winningest coach in the shortest period of time than any other UWRF hockey coach. His teams have averaged over 20 wins a season during his tenure. In the NCAA Div. III, Freeman is fifth in winning percentage (.689) of active coaches. His winning percentage is better than any NCAA Div. I coach. His 183 career wins ranks him 23rd in the NCAA Div. III. He has accomplished that ranking despite having coached fewer years than any other coach in the top 25 list.

Freeman has coached in a Falcon program that has played in five NCAA Frozen Four National Championships, nine NCAA National Tournaments and 10 NCHA Peters Cup Final Tournaments. He was named the NCHA Coach of the Year in 1999 and 2003 and was the WIAC Coach of the Year in 1998, 2003, 2004 and 2005.

Freeman was the No. 1 assistant for seven years and has always played a key role in the team's great success. His recruiting and leadership over the years have made the Falcons a powerhouse in Div. III hockey. The Falcons won the 1994 NCAA National Championship and participated in the NCAA Frozen Four in 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996 and 2001. The Falcons placed second in 1993, were third in 1995 and 1996 and placed fourth in 2001.

His work ethic and enthusiasm for the game has helped create a winning atmosphere in the Falcons locker room where players know what is expected from them both on and off the ice.

Freeman, a career coach, draws on his vast coaching experience from stops at the high school, Junior A and college levels to teach and motivate. He previously was a head coach/general manager in the United States Hockey League. He served as head coach at St. Mary's Springs High School where his team won a State championship. He also had great success at Stevens Point High School where his teams made several state tournament appearances. He led his teams to four conference championships. He has also coached select teams in international competition.

The New Brighton, Minn., native played hockey through the high school, Junior A and college levels. He earned his undergraduate degree from UW-Stevens Point in 1981 and his master's degree in education & professional development from UW-RF in 1999.

He has been involved with hockey symposiums and clinics both in the United States and internationally. He has often been a guest speaker/instructor at U.S.A. Hockey clinics.

Freeman is a respected instructor in the UW-RF Health and Human Performance department.

He and wife Deb reside in River Falls.
