## The Games

- UW-River Falls hosts UW-Superior on Wednesday and UW-Oshkosh on Saturday at the Karges Center in two WIAC contests.

-UWRF will try to get back on the winning track after losing at home to Stevens Point, 55-46 on Saturday. The 46 points is the least scored by the Falcons in a game in 2005-06. UWRF is led in scoring by Traci Reimann who averages 14.3 points a game. She also leads the team in rebounding with a 9.8 average. She is sixth in scoring and second in rebounding in the WIAC. Melanie Preiner is second in scoring for the Falcons (12.7) and she leads the WIAC in steals (55). Preiner scored 17 points to lead the Falcons to a win against UWS earlier this year. The Falcons are tied with Eau Claire and Platteville for fifth place in the WIAC.

-UWS will be looking to snap a three game losing streak when they travel to UWRF on Wednesday. Katie Moench leads the Jackets in scoring averaging 14.9 points a game. Jenny Carlson, who is second in scoring with a 9.5 average, leads UWS in rebounding with a 4.9 average. Moench scored 17 points when the two teams met in November.

-UWO is in first place in the WIAC, two games ahead of second place Stevens Point and Stout (6-3). The Titans lead the WIAC in scoring margin (+12.7). Brittany Herrick, whose father, Daryl, is a 1975 UWRF graduate, leads the Titans averaging 17.7 points a game. If teams key on her, teammate Shannon Eggers can make the difference. She is second in the WIAC in scoring averaging 16.1 points a game. Herrick is third in the WIAC in rebounding (7.2). Kelly O'Keef averages 12.5 points a game and is a deadly shooter from the outside. She leads the WIAC in three pointers (56) and three-point shooting percentage (.505). Herrick scored 24 points and Eggers 20 in the meeting between UWRF and UWO earlier this year.

## Head Coach - Cindy Hovet

Cindy Hovet enters her sixth year as the head basketball coach at UW-River Falls with the 2005-06 season.

Hovet was inducted into the UW-Stout Athletic Hall of Fame in November. She is the only person who has been named a WIAC Coach of the Year (2001) and named a WIAC Player of the Year (1994).

The 2004-05 Falcons had another fine season finishing 17-8 overall and 10-6 and in fourth place in the highly competitive WIAC. The 17 wins and 10 WIAC victories were the second most by a Hovet coached team. She needs just six wins to reach 75 in her career. She has coached five players who have received All-WIAC honors; including Erin Effle who was the 2005 WIAC women's basketball Scholar-Athlete.

The 2003-04 season concluded with a 13-13 overall record, and 4-12 in the WIAC. Although the team didn't do as well in conference play as they had hoped, they managed to put together a perfect 9-0 non-conference record. That perfect record included impressive victories against two NCAA national tournament qualifiers, Lakeland College (22-6) and Maryville University (23-3). Both Lakeland and Maryville went undefeated and were champions of their respective conferences, which again highlights the strength and parity in the WIAC where the Falcons finished seventh in 2003-04.

The Falcons will take on another strong schedule in 2005-06. Besides facing each of the WIAC teams twice, the Falcons have nine non-conference games. The Falcons will play at St. Thomas on Nov. 27. The Tommies have won more MIAC titles (10) than any other institution. The Falcons also play a road game at NCAA Div. II Winona State (Dec. 11). In all the Falcons play six games against teams that were either ranked or earned votes in the D3hoops.com preseason Top 25 poll.

The two years prior to last season, the Falcons have finished in sixth place in the WIAC with a 10-15 overall record in 2002-03 and 11-15 in 2001-02. Hovet's first season at the helm for UWRF was the program's most successful since 1988-89. With an 18-8 overall record, they tied for third place in the conference. Hovet was named the WIAC Coach of the Year for the team's accomplishments that season.

Hovet was the UWRF head tennis coach and assistant basketball coach for five years before taking over the basketball program in 2000-01. Her playing career was also in the WIAC. As a student-athlete at UW-Stout she was a two-time All-WIAC first team selection in 1993 and 1994. Her senior season she was named the 1994 WIAC Player of the Year and earned All-American honors. She was named to the second All-WIAC team in 1992. She helped the Blue Devils to a 76-27 record and berths in both the NCAA Division III and NAIA National Tournaments for four seasons.

Hovet received her Psychology undergraduate degree and Coaching minor from UW-Stout. She completed here Master's Degree in Kinesiology with an emphasis in Sport Psychology and Sociology at the University of Minnesota. She currently teaches at UWRF in the health & human performance department along with her coaching duties.

## Last Week's Results

The Falcons had one of their best all-around games in a 74-52 win over UW-La Crosse on Wednesday at the Karges Center. The Falcons trailed at the half, 36-33, and it was the first time this year that the Falcons won a game in which they trailed at the half. UWRF outscored UWL, 41-16, in the second half. Four Falcons scored in double figures led by Melanie Preiner who finished with 20. Megan Lindman scored 17 and Traci Reimann and Krista Cordes each scored 12. Reimann led the Falcons with seven rebounds. The Falcons shot a season best .542 from the field finishing 26-48. They were 11-19 from three-point range and 11-12 at the line. Mackenzie Hunter led UWL with 15 points.

Against Stevens Point on Saturday at the Karges Center, the Pointers took a 55-46 win in a WIAC game that had the Falcons score their lowest point total of the season. Lindman led the Falcons with 16 points. Preiner had another solid game with 12 points. Reimann scored six points and led the Falcons with nine rebounds and four assists. Preiner had seven rebounds. UWRF shot just 17-69 (.246) from the field, including 3-19 (.158) from three-point range. They were 9-16 (.563) from the line. UWSP was led by Laura Neuenfeldt and Jesirae Heuer who both scored 10 points. UWSP shot 17-42 (.405) from the floor, including 1-12 (.083) from behind the arc. They were 20-29 (.690) from the line. The Pointers had a 47-38 advantage in rebounding.

The Falcons women's basketball picked up their first conference win of the season 70-53, Wednesday night at Superior.

RF was led by Melanie Preiner who had a team high 20 points, four steals, and three assists in 38 minutes of action. Miranda Biteler chipped in with 13 points and three assists. Megan Lindman added 14 points and five rebounds. Jana Benitz came off the bench to score 11 points and Traci Reimann had a team high seven rebounds.

In the first half, RF shot 40.7 percent (11-27) from the field and 50 percent (2-4) from the free throw line. They also made five three-pointers. Superior shot 44 percent (11-25) for the half. The score at halftime was 29-28 RF.

In the second half, RF took control shooting 45.5 percent (10-22) and hitting many clutch free throws (17-20). They also made four three-pointers. Superior shot the ball worse in the second half only making 30.8 percent (8-26). RF outscored the Yellow Jackets 41-25 in the second half.

For the game RF shot 42.9 percent (21-49) and 79.2 percent (19-24) from the free throw line. RF shot 45 percent (9-20) from the three point line. Superior shot 37.3 percent (19-51) from the field.

Superior was led by Katie Moench who had 17 points and six rebounds. Molly Ray and Whitney Johnson each pitched in with 10 points.

**UW-River Falls vs. Oshkosh -- Last Meeting**

The Falcon comeback effort at UW-Oshkosh fell just short on Saturday afternoon as the Titans took a 75-72 win at the Kolf Sports Center.

The Falcons trailed by nine (53-44) with 14:29 to play in the second half. But the Falcons went on a 6-0 run to get to within 53-50 with 12:18 to play when Traci Reimann scored on a lay up. The Titans led by between one and five points until UWRF took a 65-64 lead with 3:23 to play when Jana Benitz hit a three-pointer. Oshkosh took a two point lead (67-65) when Kelly O'Keefe hit a three with 3:19 to play. The Falcons tied the game (67-67) with 3:07 to play when Reimann hit two free throws. But UWO took a 69-67 lead with 2:33 to play when Eggers hit two free throws. UWO went ahead 71-67 with 1:33 to go when Herrick hit a jumper. But the Falcons took a lead (72-71) with :28 to play when Melanie Preiner scored on a lay up, was fouled, and made the free throw. With :22 to play, Herrick was fouled and she hit two free throws to put the Titans ahead for good, 73-72. Then with just 13 seconds to play Becky Knapp was fouled and she made both free throws to give UWO a 75-72 lead.

The Falcons were led by Miranda Biteler who scored a career high 26 points. She was 9-15 from the field, including 7-9 from three-point range. She was 1-2 at the line and had seven rebounds. The seven three-pointers made is the second most by a Falcon in a single game. Reimann scored 14 points and led all players with 16 rebounds. She had 16 rebounds once earlier this year and that is her season high. The Falcons shot 25-60 from the field (.417), including 11-24 (.458) from three-point range. They were 11-16 (.688) from the line. The Falcons had a 44-31 advantage in rebounds.

UWO was led by Herrick who scored 24 points and she grabbed nine rebounds. Eggers scored 20 points and O'Keef scored 21. The Titans were 24-58 (.414) from the field, including 8-24 (.333) from three-point range. They were a near perfect 19-20 (.950) from the line.
