The Games

- UW-River Falls plays one road and one home WIAC games this week. Wednesday the Falcons take the short trip to Menomonie to face UW-Stout. On Saturday the Falcons return to the Karges Center and host UW-Platteville. Both games start at 7 p.m.

-UWRF is coming off a very successful week. The Falcons beat UW-Superior on Wednesday, 56-46, and then topped WIAC leading UW-Oshkosh, 67-48, on Saturday. Both games were at the Karges Center. The Falcons have fashioned an 8-3 record at Karges this year. The bad news is that the Falcons have only one more home regular season game - that's Saturday against Platteville. Earlier this year the Falcons dropped a 71-59 decision to UW-Stout, and lost a 63-61 game at UW-Platteville. Traci Reimann continues to lead the Falcons in scoring (14.3) and rebounding (10.4). She is one of only two players in the WIAC who are averaging in double digits in scoring and rebounding - the other is Stout's Kelsey Duoss. Melanie Preiner is second in scoring for the Falcons (12.3) and she leads the team in assists (76) and steals (39).

-UWS's Kelsey Duoss leads the WIAC in both scoring (19.3) and rebounding (10.6). Lindsey Geissler is second (7.6) and Molly Hendricks third (7.2). Hendricks is second in rebounding (4.6). Stout is second in the WIAC in rebounding margin (+6.1). In the game between the Falcons and Blue Devils earlier this year, UWS forced 23 Falcon turnovers - the second most by UWRF this season.

-UWP has lost five straight WIAC games. Holly Kaiser leads the Pioneers in scoring (14.1) and is second in rebounding (5.1). Liz Tesch is second in scoring (10.2) and leads the Pioneers in field goal shooting (.461). Lisa Grantman leads UWP in rebounding (6.6) and Kaiser leads the team in assists (40) and steals (28).

Head Coach - Cindy Hovet

Cindy Hovet enters her sixth year as the head basketball coach at UW-River Falls with the 2005-06 season.

Hovet was inducted into the UW-Stout Athletic Hall of Fame in November. She is the only person who has been named a WIAC Coach of the Year (2001) and named a WIAC Player of the Year (1994).

The 2004-05 Falcons had another fine season finishing 17-8 overall and 10-6 and in fourth place in the highly competitive WIAC. The 17 wins and 10 WIAC victories were the second most by a Hovet coached team. She needs just six wins to reach 75 in her career. She has coached five players who have received All-WIAC honors; including Erin Effle who was the 2005 WIAC women's basketball Scholar-Athlete.

The 2003-04 season concluded with a 13-13 overall record, and 4-12 in the WIAC. Although the team didn't do as well in conference play as they had hoped, they managed to put together a perfect 9-0 non-conference record. That perfect record included impressive victories against two NCAA national tournament qualifiers, Lakeland College (22-6) and Maryville University (23-3). Both Lakeland and Maryville went undefeated and were champions of their respective conferences, which again highlights the strength and parity in the WIAC where the Falcons finished seventh in 2003-04.

The Falcons will take on another strong schedule in 2005-06. Besides facing each of the WIAC teams twice, the Falcons have nine non-conference games. The Falcons will play at St. Thomas on Nov. 27. The Tommies have won more MIAC titles (10) than any other institution. The Falcons also play a road game at NCAA Div. II Winona State (Dec. 11). In all the Falcons play six games against teams that were either ranked or earned votes in the D3hoops.com preseason Top 25 poll.

The two years prior to last season, the Falcons have finished in sixth place in the WIAC with a 10-15 overall record in 2002-03 and 11-15 in 2001-02. Hovet's first season at the helm for UWRF was the program's most successful since 1988-89. With an 18-8 overall record, they tied for third place in the conference. Hovet was named the WIAC Coach of the Year for the team's accomplishments that season.

Hovet was the UWRF head tennis coach and assistant basketball coach for five years before taking over the basketball program in 2000-01. Her playing career was also in the WIAC. As a student-athlete at UW-Stout she was a two-time All-WIAC first team selection in 1993 and 1994. Her senior season she was named the 1994 WIAC Player of the Year and earned All-American honors. She was named to the second All-WIAC team in 1992. She helped the Blue Devils to a 76-27 record and berths in both the NCAA Division III and NAIA National Tournaments for four seasons.

Hovet received her Psychology undergraduate degree and Coaching minor from UW-Stout. She completed here Master's Degree in Kinesiology with an emphasis in Sport Psychology and Sociology at the University of Minnesota. She currently teaches at UWRF in the health & human performance department along with her coaching duties.

Last Week's Results

On Wednesday against Superior Traci Reimann had a double-double finishing with 15 points and 17 rebounds. Melanie Preiner scored 13 points. Kim Sorenson finished four three points, four rebounds and a team-high six assists. The Falcons finished 8-17 (.471) at the line and the Jackets did not shoot a free throw in the game. RF shot 2-58 (.379) from the floor, including 4-17 (.235) from three-point range. UWS shot 19-57 (.333) from the floor, including 8-23 (.348) from behind the arc.

The Falcons topped UW-Oshkosh, 67-48 on Saturday afternoon at the Karges Center. UWO was in first place in the WIAC entering the game. The score was tied four times in the first half. With the score tied 16-16, the Falcons went on a 10-0 run to take a 26-16 lead with 2:03 to play. UWO got to within four twice in the second half, the last time, 34-30, with 14:56 to play. The Falcons had five players score in double figures led by Krista Cordes who had 14. Cordes went 4-6 from three-point range in the second half. She also had four rebounds. Traci Reimann finished with a double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds. Megan Lindman scored 13 points and had four rebounds. Miranda Biteler scored 12 points and had four assists and four steals while Kim Sorenson scored a career high 11 points. Melanie Preiner led the Falcons with seven assists.

The Falcons played their second conference game of the break and game up short against Stout, 71-59.

The Falcons did not receive much help in the scoring department other than Traci Reimann's 27 points, one point short of her career high. After Reimann the next leading scorer for River Falls was Melanie Preiner with 10.

The Falcons jumped out to an 11-5 lead three minutes into the first half. The River Falls run would end at 13 where Stout took the lead, 15-1., after a jumper from Steffanie Nemitz. Reimann tried to keep the Falcons in the game with her 15 first half points but she wasn't getting any help elsewhere. Stout extended their lead to 25-15 with a three from Molly Hendricks. The Falcons went into the locker room losing to the Blue Devils, 45-29.

The second half started off decent for River Falls as they were able to cut the Stout lead down to single digits two minutes in, 45-36. The Falcon run would end there as Stout steamed ahead for the win. Reimann not only led the team in scoring, she also pulled down eight boards to take that category as well.

The story of the game was simply River Falls not getting much from anyone besides Reimann. Krista Cordes only had three points coming off of her 24 point performance against UW-Whitewater and Megan Lindman added eight.

RF was led by Traci Reimann who had a team high 23 points and 12 rebounds. Also in double figures were Jana Benitz who had 13 points and Melanie Preiner who had 10 points. Miranda Biteler chipped in with five assists and Megan Lindman had seven rebounds.

In the first half, RF took the early 4-0 lead but UWP responded late in the first half with a 36-28 lead before Lindman made a layup to cut into the lead. UWP led at half 36-30.

In the second half, RF played much better getting the game to within a point after a Krista Cordes made a jumper to make the score 53-52 with 8:26 left in the game, but that's the closest the Falcons got. Platteville went on a run and closed the game with a few clutch free throws to secure the win 63-61.
