The Game

UW-River Falls opens WIAC tournament play on the road on Monday when they travel to UW-La Crosse for a 7 p.m. game. The Falcons ended their regular season at La Crosse on Feb. 15 with a 56-49 loss to the Eagles. Earlier this year at the Karges Center the Falcons took a 74-52 win over UWL.. The two teams have never met in the WIAC playoffs since the start of the tourney in 1999. The Falcons are 2-5 in first round games in tournament history. Falcon Coach Cindy Hovet has a 7-4 record against La Crosse. Her teams are 3-3 at Mitchell Hall. Hovet has a 1-5 record in the league playoffs. If the Falcons win at UWL, they would play the winner of the Whitewater-Stout game on Wednesday. The championship game is set for Saturday at the site of the highest remaining seeded team.

-UWRF is led in scoring by guard Melanie Preiner who averages 11.9 points a game. Guard Miranda Biteler is second in scoring with a 10.1 average. The Falcons have been without leading scorer Traci Reimann for the last four games of the season. She has been out of the lineup with a broken bone in her foot. She averages 14.2 points and 10.5 rebounds a game. Preiner also leads the team in three-pointers (55), assists (82) and steals (71). She is second in rebounding (4.7). Megan Lindman averages nine points and 4.4 rebounds a game and she leads the team in blocks (24.). The Falcons are 2-10 on the road this year.

-UWL is led in scoring by Mackenzie Hunter who averages 11.1 points a game. Nicole Palmer is second with a 10.5 average. Katy Searing, who averages 8.6 points a game, is the top rebounder with a 6.7 average. The Eagles have an 8-3 record at home.

Head Coach - Cindy Hovet

Cindy Hovet enters her sixth year as the head basketball coach at UW-River Falls with the 2005-06 season.

Hovet was inducted into the UW-Stout Athletic Hall of Fame in November. She is the only person who has been named a WIAC Coach of the Year (2001) and named a WIAC Player of the Year (1994).

The 2004-05 Falcons had another fine season finishing 17-8 overall and 10-6 and in fourth place in the highly competitive WIAC. The 17 wins and 10 WIAC victories were the second most by a Hovet coached team. She needs just six wins to reach 75 in her career. She has coached five players who have received All-WIAC honors; including Erin Effle who was the 2005 WIAC women's basketball Scholar-Athlete.

The 2003-04 season concluded with a 13-13 overall record, and 4-12 in the WIAC. Although the team didn't do as well in conference play as they had hoped, they managed to put together a perfect 9-0 non-conference record. That perfect record included impressive victories against two NCAA national tournament qualifiers, Lakeland College (22-6) and Maryville University (23-3). Both Lakeland and Maryville went undefeated and were champions of their respective conferences, which again highlights the strength and parity in the WIAC where the Falcons finished seventh in 2003-04.

The Falcons will take on another strong schedule in 2005-06. Besides facing each of the WIAC teams twice, the Falcons have nine non-conference games. The Falcons will play at St. Thomas on Nov. 27. The Tommies have won more MIAC titles (10) than any other institution. The Falcons also play a road game at NCAA Div. II Winona State (Dec. 11). In all the Falcons play six games against teams that were either ranked or earned votes in the D3hoops.com preseason Top 25 poll.

The two years prior to last season, the Falcons have finished in sixth place in the WIAC with a 10-15 overall record in 2002-03 and 11-15 in 2001-02. Hovet's first season at the helm for UWRF was the program's most successful since 1988-89. With an 18-8 overall record, they tied for third place in the conference. Hovet was named the WIAC Coach of the Year for the team's accomplishments that season.

Hovet was the UWRF head tennis coach and assistant basketball coach for five years before taking over the basketball program in 2000-01. Her playing career was also in the WIAC. As a student-athlete at UW-Stout she was a two-time All-WIAC first team selection in 1993 and 1994. Her senior season she was named the 1994 WIAC Player of the Year and earned All-American honors. She was named to the second All-WIAC team in 1992. She helped the Blue Devils to a 76-27 record and berths in both the NCAA Division III and NAIA National Tournaments for four seasons.

Hovet received her Psychology undergraduate degree and Coaching minor from UW-Stout. She completed here Master's Degree in Kinesiology with an emphasis in Sport Psychology and Sociology at the University of Minnesota. She currently teaches at UWRF in the health & human performance department along with her coaching duties.

UWL had a 25-13 lead at the half and held a 32-13 lead with 17:27 to play in the game. The Falcons cut that lead to 49-45 with 1:05 left. La Crosse was 10-12 at the line in the last 1:29 of the game. La Crosse was led by Mackenzie Hunter who scored 20 points. She had four rebounds and four assists. Ashley Wagner added 11 points. Nicole Palmer led the Eagles with six rebounds. UWRF held a 38-34 advantage in rebounds. The Falcons shot 17-47 (.362) from the field, including 5-19 (.263) from three-point range. They were 10-14 (.714) from the line. UWL shot 18-57 (.316) from the field and 1-12 (.083) from behind the arc. They were 19-24 (.792) from the line.

River Falls 74, La Crosse 52

The Falcon women's basketball team invited La Crosse to Karges on Wednesday night and won big, 74-52.

River Falls started off hot and jumped out to a 14-4 lead after a three from Jana Benitz with 14:49 left in the first half. The Falcons were on fire from long range all night where they went 11-19 (.579) for the game. Melanie Preiner led the Falcons in scoring with 20, she also added seven assists and five rebounds. River Falls allowed La Crosse to stay in the game in the first half and went into the locker room trailing 33-35.

The second half was all River Falls as they were able to take the lead back early and never look back. The Falcons pushed their lead to 51-40 following a three pointer from Preiner with 11:58 remaining in the game. River Falls shot 26-48 (.542) from the field compared to La Crosse's 20-57 (.351). The night proved to be one of River Falls' most consistant nights in the shooting departement. After Preiner, Megan Lindman was second on the team in scoring with 17, followed by 12 from both Krista Cordes and Traci Reimann. The Falcons took control of the game and rolled to a 22 point victory.

The Falcons fell at UW-La Crosse 56-49 Wednesday night at Mitchell Hall.

RF was led by Melanie Preiner's 16 points and three steals. Krista Cordes had a double double scoring 11 points and grabbing a team high 10 rebounds. Miranda Biteler dished out a team high five assists and added three steals.

UW-LaCrosse was led by Mackenzie Hunter's 20 points and four assists. She shot 7/17 from the field including 6/7 from the free throw line. Ashley Wagner added 11 points and three assists. Nicole Palmer had a team high six rebounds and she added seven points.

UWRF shot just 17-47 (36.2%) from the field, including 5-19 (26.3%) from behind the arc. They were 10-14 (71.4%) from the line. UWL shot just 18-57 (31.6%) from the field, and just 1-12 (8.3%) from three-point range. They were 19-24 (79.2%) from the line. The Eagles had more rebounds with a 38-34 advantage.

UWL opened the game on a 11-3 run which was capped off by a Samantha Schmitz jumper with 11:24 left in the half. After a couple of Cordes free throws cut the lead to 13-8, UWL responded with a 10-3 run to make the score 23-11 with 3:51 left in the half. Each team scored one more basket and the score at recess was 25-13 UWL.

In the second half, the Eagles poured it on starting the half going on a 7-0 run to put the Eagles up 32-13. RF mounted a furious comeback going on a 32-17 run to get within just four points with 1:05 left in the game. The comeback was squashed by UWL's free throw shooting. They made many clutch free throws down the stretch including their last seven of the game. UWL won the game 56-49.
