The Game

* The Falcons travel to southwest Wisconsin on Saturday to face UW-Platteville in a WIAC game at Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium. Kick off is set for 1 p.m.

* The Falcons earned a 24-20 come-from-behind win over UW-Stout last weekend at Ramer Field. Trailing 20-7 at the start of the fourth quarter, the Falcons scored 17 points to get the win. UWP lost a 49-21 decision at home to Whitewater, the second ranked team in the country.

* Falcon punter Jovin Kroll leads the WIAC with a 40.9 average. He had a 68-yard punt against Stout last week and that is the second longest in the WIAC this season. He was named the WIAC special teams Player of the Week and he was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week after he averaged 46.8 yards per kick against Stout. End Gregg Neumann continues to lead the conference in sacks with 6.5. End Nathan Renk is tied with UWP's Brandon Willger with three fumbles recovered. Platteville's Joe Danielson (5.1) and Brian Gallick (4.8) are 1-2 in the league in receptions per game.

* The Falcons are on the road for the fifth time this season on Saturday and will be on the road for the next two games. After Saturday's game against the Pioneers, the Falcons travel to UW-La Crosse on Nov. 4.

* This is the 50th meeting between UWRP and UWP. The Falcons hold a 30-17-2 lead in the series. The Falcons have won the last 13 games. Since 1970 the Falcons are 11-7 at UWP.

* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season at UW-RF, has a 95-79-3 career record. He is 14-2-1 against UWP and has a 6-2 record at Platteville. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRP and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. The win last week against UW-Stout put him No. 7 in all-time wins in the WIAC.

* Coach Mike Emendorfer is in his eighth year at UWP and has a 27-49 overall record. He has a 14-39 record in WIAC play.

* The game is scheduled to be broadcast on FSN North Wisconsin on Tuesday, Oct. 31 at 6:30 p.m.

River Falls - Stout Recap

The Falcon football team picked up a dramatic 24-20 victory over Stout Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

Stout opened the game up quickly on the opening drive of the game going 80 yards in five plays, which was capped off by a 24-yard Tanner Kattre run to make the score 7-0 Stout.

In the second quarter, the Blue Devils took over at their own 33-yard and drove the ball all the way down to the Falcon eight-yard line, stalled and Brandon Raciborski kicked a 25-yard field goal to give UWS a 10-0 lead with 9:34 left in the first half.

RF finally got on the board on their next possession going 80 yards in nine plays, which was capped off by a 3-yard Beau DeBruin touch-down run to make the score 10-7. The key play of the drive was a 28-yard Jeremy Wolff to Josh Grover pass on a second-and-five play from the UWRF 25.

After a 28-yard Jovin Kroll punt, the Blue Devils set up shop at the RF 43-yard line with only 1:17 left in the half. They moved the ball quickly and got all the way down to the Falcon 25-yard line with only play. The drive stalled and Raciborski connected on a 42-yard field goal to make the score 13-7 Stout at recess.

Midway through the third quarter the Blue Devils forced a Nathan Anderson fumble at the Falcon 26-yard line. Stout scored on the next play going through the air this time with a 26-yard Kattre to Jesse Wendt pass to take a commanding 20-7 lead with 3:54 to play in the third quarter.

To begin the fourth quarter the Falcons set up shop at their own 15-yard line. After a heavy dose of Anderson the Falcons moved the ball all the way down to the Stout one-yard line. After failing three times to punch it in the end zone the Falcons decided to go for it on fourth down and Wolff came through with a 1-yard quarterback sneak for the touchdown to make the score 20-14 Stout.

Later in the fourth quarter, with only 4:08 left in the game, Stout lined up to punt and the Falcon special teams came up big with a Bruce Baillargeon blocked punt. The ball rolled out of bounds at the Stout two and the Falcons scored one play later with a two-yard Wolff plunge to make the score 21-20.

On the ensuing kickoff Michael Mueller forced a Stout fumble that Ben Arata recovered at the Stout 18 with 3:41 to play. UWRF moved the ball five yards in four plays and Spasimir Bodurski kicked a 35-yard field goal to give the Falcons a 24-20 lead with 2:58 to play. The field goal forced Stout to have to move the ball all the way for a touchdown.

Stout's last chance came with just under three minutes left in the game. They moved the ball all the way down to the Falcon 43-yard line, but came up short turning it over on downs. The Falcons downed the ball and picked up a huge 24-20 comeback win.

Anderson led the Falcon ground game with 106 yards on 29 carries. Wolff threw for 124 yards and ran for 18. He was 7-13. Grover added 108 yards on five catches. Stout was led by Kattre who threw for 132 yards and one touchdown. He finished 12-21. Wendt caught six passes for 86 yards and one touchdown. Ryan Englebert led UWS with 16 carries for 80 yards.

On defense the Falcons were led by Andy Kolstad who had 12 total tackles. Arata added nine and Bruce Baillargeon and Dan Buker each chipped in with eight each.

The win gives Falcon coach John O'Grady his 95th of his career. The 95 wins put him seventh in victories in the WIAC. He is third among active WIAC coaches in wins.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 95-79-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .545. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is seventh in all-time wins. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.



Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 62-52-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.

Platteville - Whitewater Recap

Second-ranked UW-Whitewater extended its Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference winning streak to 12 games and ruined UW-Platteville's Homecoming with a 49-21 victory during a steady rain at Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium Saturday.

Playing without injured all-American running back Justin Beaver, the Warhawks used six scoring passes, including five by Justin Jacobs. The Warhawks remained perfect with a 7-0 overall mark, including 5-0 in the WIAC. The Pioneers fell to 4-3, 2-2.

Despite the pouring rain, the two teams exchanged long-bomb touchdowns in the opening four minutes. The Pioneers' Brent Nelson hit Joe Danielson with an 89-yard scoring strike before most fans had a chance to open their umbrellas. The Warhawks, who found themselves trailing for the first time all season, answered one play later when Jacobs threw an 80-yard touchdown pass to Derek Stanley, making it 7-7 3:51 into the game.

Jacobs connected with Stanely again from 17 yards out and with Lance Douglas from 18 yards away for first-quarter scores.

The Pioneers cut the lead to 21-14 when receiver Derek Hoff threw a 29-yard scoring pass to Brian Gallick, one play after Matt Eastlick recovered a Warhawk fumble.

UWW answered back with a 69-yard drive, capped by Jacobs' two-yard pass to Pete Schmitt, making it 28-14 at the half.

Derek Underwood's nine-yard TD run was the only third-quarter score, and Jacobs hit Schmitt again with a 12-yard pass early in the fourth quarter.

Gallick caught his second scoring pass of the game with 5:58 to play, an 11-yard pass from reserve quarterback Michael Schmidt.

After recovering on-sides kick, the Warhawks went 48 yards in three plays, with Neil Mrkvicka catching a 44-yard pass from Brian Ryczkowski to finish the scoring with 4:29 remaining.

The game is played in memory of late Pioneer Coach George Chryst, who died suddenly in 1992. The assembled media select players of the game, and the media honored Danielson, who caught eight passes for 137 yards, and Jacobs, who completed 26 of 37 passes for 342 yards and five TDs, on offense. Defensive stalwarts honored were Eastlick, who had 11 tackles, the fumble recovery, and two passes broken up, and UWW linebacker A.J. Raebel, who made eight tackles, including a 14-yard QB sack, and broke up a pass.

Travis Reuland added 116 yards rushing in place of Beaver for the Warhawks, while Gallick caught seven passes for 83 yards for the Pioneers.

David Pietrowiak had a diving interception for the Pioneers, while Brandon Willger recovered two fumbles, and Ryan Glynn returned a fumble 21 yards to set up the last Pioneer score.

UW-Platteville Coach Mike Emendorfer is anxious to see his 2006 team on the field to erase an injury-riddled 2005 campaign.

Because of injuries, 40 different players started at least once for the Pioneers, who struggled to a 1-9 mark. The bright side, however, is that Emendorfer returns a vast array of talent and experience to bring the Pioneers back to the level of play they had the previous year.

Emendorfer earned the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year Award for 2004, a season in which the Pioneers achieved their first winning record since 1992.

The Pioneers finished 6-4, beating top-20 teams Augustana, UW-Whitewater and UW-Eau Claire. Emendorfer also took his team out to Pennsylvania, where the Pioneers beat Thiel 40-14. Along the way, the team toured Notre Dame and its stadium as well as the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

In his seven years, Emendorfer has guided the Pioneers to the most explosive offensive era in the 107-year history of the football program.

The Pioneers have rewritten the record books, establishing 25 school records and breaking 10 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference marks. In addition, Emendorfer's teams have produced 35 all-conference players, two all-Americans, five academic all-district selections and a WIAC Scholar-Athlete winner. The Pioneers have ranked among the nation's passing leaders in each of the last four years. They finished 15th in 2004.

Excitement has been the trademark of the football program in the last three years, as an incredible 16 games have been won or lost on the final play of the game, with three 2002 games needing overtime. The Pioneers have produced some memorable moments in that time, such as beating WIAC favorite UW-Stout 34-31 in overtime on Homecoming 2002 and topping NCAA Division I Drake 21-20 in 2003 and by 33-23 in 2004. UW-Platteville won two games on the final play in 2004, defeating Augustana 25-23 on a last-second field goal and UW-Eau Claire 20-17, when Emendorfer by-passed a chip shot field goal and went for the win with a successful one-yard touchdown plunge.

Emendorfer came to UW-Platteville from Hanover (Ind.) College, where he had been the offensive coordinator for eight years. During that time, Hanover won three conference titles, produced two NCAA III playoff berths and led the nation in passing four times. The Pioneers repeated that success in 2001 by leading all of NCAA III in passing yardage.

UW-RF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 29-22 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 25-16 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-35 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 475-313-49 record in 103 seasons.

UWRF 28, UWP 21

The Falcons picked up a much-needed win 28-21 over UW-Platteville Saturday afternoon at Ramer field.

RF got on the board first on a Spasimir Bodurski 20-yard field goal. It was set up by a Sean Wolf fumble recovery at the UWP 23-yard line. The RF drive covered 20 yards in six plays.

The Falcons scored the first points of the second quarter on another Bodurski field goal, this time from 47 yards out. His field goal was a school record. The drive covered 58 yards in 14 plays. On UWP's next possession Tyson Droessler scored a two-yard touchdown to give the Pioneers a 7-6 lead. The drive covered 44 yards in seven plays.

After a 48-yard Matt Jordan kickoff return, the Falcons scored three plays later on a Nathan Anderson three-yard run. Jeremy Wolff added the two-point conversion to make the score 14-7 RF. The drive covered 31 yards in three plays. RF added another touchdown late in the second quarter on the legs of Wolff. He ran it in from three yards out to make the score 21-7 at half. The drive covered for 55 yards in seven plays.

RF scored the only points of the third quarter on another Wolff touchdown run. He ran it in from 16 yards out to make the score 28-7 heading into the fourth quarter. The drive covered 89 yards in 13 plays.

UWP got on the board early in the fourth quarter on a Damian Droessler one-yard run. The drive covered 65 yards in 13 plays. The Pioneers scored the last points of the game on a Mike Genslinger 24-yard touchdown run to make the score 28-21 RF. The drive covered 80 yards in nine plays. That ended the scoring.

The Falcons were led by Anderson's 156 yards on the ground and one touchdown. It was Anderson's fifth 100+ rushing game of the season and the 10th of his career. He has rushed for 1,072 yards in 2005. Wolff also ran for over 100 yards chipping in with 136 yards and two touchdowns. UWP was led by Tyson Droessler's 129 yards on the ground and one touchdown. Michael Schmidt threw for 112 yards but had three interceptions.

On defense the Falcons were led by Ryan Agrimson who had seven solo and four assisted tackles. Shane Hanson (6-4), Dan Buker (5-3), and Robby Nesvig (2-5) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Hanson, Nesvig, and Andy Acosta also added interceptions.
