The Game

- * The Falcons are on the road again for a WIAC game at UW-Eau Claire on Saturday. Kick off is set for 1 p.m. at Carson Park.
- * Both teams lost WIAC games last weekend by shutouts. The Falcons were blanked by Oshkosh, 24-0, while the Blugolds were beaten by Whitewater, 34-0. Both UWRF and UWEC were at home.
- * The Falcons were shutout for the first time since Nov. 23, 1996 when La Crosse beat the Falcons, 44-0. That was a NCAA Div. III playoff game in La Crosse. The last regular season shutout of the Falcons was at Stevens Point (37-0) on Nov. 7, 1987. The last time the Falcons were shutout at home was Sept. 9, 1972 (28-0) by Augsburg.
- * This is the 86th meeting between the two teams. UWRF holds a 46-32-7 lead in the all-time series that started in 1919. UWEC has won the past four games and that is the Blugolds longest winning streak in the series. The Falcons won 12 straight games between 1923-34.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season at UW-RF, has a 93-78-3 career record. He is 9-8 against UWEC. He is a 1979 graduate of UW-RF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He needs two wins to get to No. 7 in all-time wins in the WIAC.
- * Coach Todd Glaser is in his first season at UW-Eau Claire. He has a 1-3 record with the Blugolds and is 0-1 in WIAC games.

- * After Saturday's game against the Blugolds the Falcons return to Ramer Field on Oct. 14 for a game against UW-Stevens Point that starts at 2 p.m.

River Falls - Oshkosh Recap

The Falcons fell short of scoring on multiple possessions and was not able to stick with a strong Oshkosh offense as the Titans took a 24-0 win at Ramer Field Saturday night.

The first quarter made clear what the end result of the game would be. Both teams fizzled out on their first possession but Oshkosh capitalized on their second. Following a 2-yard punt return by the Titans' Steve Stoltz to the River Falls 45, UWO went on a mission to find paydirt. The anticipation did not last long thanks to Titan running back Andy Moriarty's 34-yard rumble to the RF 11. Moriarty would finish what he started three plays later on a 3-yard run for the game's first score.

The Falcons were forced to turn to the passing game due to minimal gain on the ground and proved to be somewhat successful. RF quarterback Jeremy Wolff locked in on receiver Josh Grover for much of the game. On the Falcons third possession on the game, Grover made his biggest impact with a 47-yard reception

The drive continued into the second quarter, eventually ending in a Wolff toss up to Grover that was intercepted in the end zone by UWO's Ryan Radtke. Grover held the most impressive Falcon stat line of the night as he hauled in five receptions for 113 yards. Only two Falcon receivers caught passes, the other being Jake Jenson who caught a seven yard dump off from Wolff in the second quarter to pick up a first down.

UWO would increase their lead with 9:53 remaining in the second quarter to 10 following a Lucas Raschke 36-yard field goal. The Titan field goal was their lone of the game as Raschke went 1-2 on the night, missing a 43-yard attempt in the fourth quarter.

Falcon running back Nathan Anderson was RF's only force on the ground as he closed out the half with three consecutive runs. Anderson rumbled to 101 yards in the game on 31 carries. It was his 13th 100+ yard rushing game of his career.

The second half did not prove to be any better for the Falcons. Behind by 17 following a UWO 57-yard touchdown reception by Steve Stoltz coming with 4:56 remaining in the third, RF was forced to rely on Wolff's passing arm. Wolff finished 6-20 passing for 120 yards. The Titan defense forced Wolff out of the pocket for much of the game and forced the senior quarterback to make plays on his feet. UWO kept Wolff on a leash and held him to only 18 yards on seven scampers. Wolff looked for Grover most the night and was unsuccessful on numerous attempts to get receiver David Ubbelohde the ball.

RF trailed by 17 going into the fourth and the Titan offense shattered any hopes of a Falcon comeback. RF was led in tackles by Ryan Agrimson, who racked up 11 in the game, seven being solo. Agrimson also knotted a sack; one of two the Falcons had; the other being split between Gregg Neumann and Scott Kane.

The Titans added an insurance score with 12:55 remaining. The UWO touchdown came on a Moriarty 1-yard stumble to stamp a 57-yard 10-play drive. The Falcons would get two more possessions the rest of the game and were forced to punt each time. UWO held the ball last and ran out the last 3:52 of the game.

The Falcons 24-0 loss was their first scoreless game since 1996 when they lost to UW-La Crosse in the NCAA Div. III playoffs, 44-0.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 93-78-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .543. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins. He needs just two wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 61-51-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.

Eau Claire - Whitewater Recap Recap

The Eau Claire football team fell behind big early on its way to losing to second-ranked UW-Whitewater today 34-0 at Carson park.

The last time the Blugolds were shutout was in 1995 when they lost at UW-Stevens Point 17-0. The last time they were shutout at home was a 38-0 loss to UW-Whitewater in 1994. The loss drops the Blugolds to an overall record of 1-3 and a WIAC record of 0-1. The Warhawks improve to 4-0 overall and 2-0 in the WIAC. It was their fourth straight win against the Blugolds and the ninth consecutive win over an opponent.

In the first half, Whitewater controlled the ball for the most part in Blugold territory. After both teams were forced to punt on their first possessions, the Blugolds went three-and-out and were forced to punt on their second possession deep in their end of the field. The Warhawks Neil Mrkvicka then returned the punt 35 yards to the Blugolds 11-yard-line.

On third down at the Blugolds four-yard-line, the Warhawks were stopped short. However, the Blugolds were called for offsides and on the next play Warhawk quarterback Justin Jacobs hit Derek Stanley for a two-yard touchdown pass to make the score 7-0.

On the first Blugold play following the touchdown, the Blugolds fumbled the ball at their own 12-yard-line and the Warhawks recovered. However, the Blugolds defense would hold Whitewater to a 28-yard field goal and the score was 10-0. The Blugolds went three-and-out on their next possession and the Warhawks took over at the Eau Claire 39-yard-line. On the next play, Jacobs hit Stanley for a 39-yard touchdown pass to make the score 17-0 with 3:26 to play in the first quarter.

After a three-and-out by the Blugolds again, Whitewater took over at the 32-yard-line. Once again, the Warhawks scored on the first play as Jacobs hit Pete Schmitt for a 32-yard touchdown pass to make the score 24-0 with 1:48 to go in the first quarter.

The Blugolds finally got their first, first down of the game on their first drive of the second quarter on a Cory Sartorelli rush. The score remained 24-0 until Warhawks kicker Jeff Schebler hit a 23-yard field goal as the first half expired to make the score 27-0 at halftime.

The Warhawks had 223 yards of total offense in the first half, compared to just 43 for the Blugolds. Whitewater had 13 first downs in the first half and the Blugolds only had two. The Warhawks had a total of five plays on their three first half touchdown drives.

The Warhawks began with the ball in the second half and drove the ball down the field. Travis Reuland capped the drive off with a one-yard touchdown run to make the score 34-0.

In the middle of the third quarter, with the Blugolds forced to punt deep in their own territory, punter Mitch Schaeuble hit a booming 83-yard punt down to the Warhawk nine-yard-line. The 83-yard punt breaks a school record previously held by Jay Aldrich, who hit a 74-yard punt against UW-Superior in 1970. It was the second longest punt in conference history. The record is 92 yards held by Warren Becker of Stevens Point in 1933.

The Blugolds got down to the five-yard-line on its final possession of the game, but were intercepted in the end zone and the game ended 34-0 in favor of Whitewater.

The Warhawks finished with 386 yards of total offense, while the Blugolds finished with 137 yards. The Warhawks were 7 of 15 on the third downs. The Blugolds, on the other hand, were just 2 of 15.

Blugold quarterback Kyle Paulson was 19 of 35 passing for 105 yards and three interceptions. Paulson along with Eddy Kaiser led the team in rushing with 17 yards. Scotty Osborn had four receptions for 38 yards to lead the Blugolds in receiving. Matt Evensen and Chris Hull also had four catches. Jake Siegert had 10 tackles to lead the Blugolds defensively.

Todd Glaser

Todd Glaser has returned to University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire...again. This time as the Blugolds' 15th head football coach.

Director of Athletics Scott Kilgallon announced in March that Glaser signed a contract to replace Todd Hoffner who resigned Feb. 10 after seven years as head coach.

Glaser had been the head coach at Marietta College in Marietta, Ohio the past three seasons after serving as Hoffner's defensive coordinator the four seasons prior to that.

Glaser is a Blugold alum who played for current Seattle Seahawks' coach Jim Lind during the 1987, 88, 89 and 90 seasons. He was the first of three brothers to don a blue and gold jersey for their collegiate careers with Tyler and Chad following in his footsteps.

Once his collegiate eligibility was completed, Glaser served as a student assistant for Lind for one season and then assisted Greg Polnasek for three seasons before leaving to become the head coach at Neillsville High School during the 1995 and 1996 campaigns. He returned to UWEC during Bob Nielson's final two years as head coach to serve as linebacker coach and strength and conditioning coordinator. He was a staff member when the Blugolds advanced to the NCAA Division III semifinals during the 1998 season.

During his final two years as the defensive coordinator in 2001 and 2002, the Blugolds produced 8-2 season records, shared the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championship in 2001 and had the second-ranked defense in yardage allowed both years.

In the 10-team Ohio Athletic Conference, which produced this year's Division III national champion Mount Union College, Glaser guided Marietta to its first back-to-back non-losing seasons in 10 years. He was the OAC Coach of the Year in 2004 when Marietta finished with a 6-4 mark. He increased the Pioneers' squad size from 48 to 125 players during his three seasons there. He was also involved in a drive that raised \$2 million for a new football field, new football locker room, new softball field and new soccer field. He was also the assistant director of the M-Team, which is the athletics' fund-raising arm of the college.

Several Blugold coaches followed Glaser to Marietta with Curt Wiese serving as his offensive coordinator and Tony Jennison as his defensive coordinator. In addition, during his three years, former Blugold players and coaches Steve Murray, Dan Larson and Nick Goeser helped coached the Pioneers.



UW-RF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 27-24 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-15 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-34 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 473-312-49 record in 103 seasons.

Last Season

UWEC 21, UWRF 11

The Falcons lost their first WIAC game of the year, 21-11, to UW-Eau Claire Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

The Blugolds took the opening possession and drove 80 yards in nine plays. Tony Hull capped off the drive with a five-yard touchdown catch from Jesse Krzyzanowski. After a Falcon punt, Eau Claire came right back on its next drive scoring again on a Krzyzanowski pass to Hull - this time from seven-yards out to make the score 14-0 after the first quarter.

RF got on the board early in the second quarter on Spasimir Bodurski's 21-yard field goal capping off a 15-play, 67-yard drive. On their very next possession the Blugolds stormed down the field and scored again on a one-yard Joe Gast touchdown run. The drive was 10 plays covering 75 yards. UWEC led at the half, 21-3.

In the third quarter RF was driving the ball and got it all the way to the UWEC 18 when Jeremy Wolff fumbled and Eau Claire's Nate Jahn recovered. There was no third quarter scoring.

The Falcons scored the only points of the fourth quarter on Chris Anderson's 13-yard touchdown catch from Wolff. Dave Affeldt added

the two-point conversion to make the score 21-11. The drive covered 85 yards in 10 plays. That ended the scoring.

RF was led by Nathan Anderson's 44 rushes for 232 yards on the ground - both were career highs. Wolff chipped in with 34 yards on the ground and one touchdown pass. Chris Anderson led the team with 34 yards receiving and one touchdown catch.

UWEC was led by Krzyzanowski's 183 yards passing and two touchdowns. He completed 15 straight passes to start the game. Gast led the team on the ground with 78 yards on 22 carries along with one touchdown. Hull had seven catches for 63 yards and two touchdowns.

Falcon cornerback Matt Jordan led the Falcon defense with six solo and 11 total tackles. Tony Dorner (3-10), Andy Acosta (4-9) and Shane Hanson (7-8) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Jeff Cassellius also added a sack for the Falcon defense.

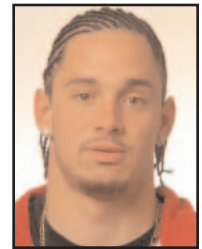
