The Game

* The Falcons end the 2006 season Saturday hosting the No. 1 team in the WIAC, UW-Whitewater, at Ramer Field. Kick off is set for 1 p.m.

* The Falcons lost a 41-17 WIAC game at UW-La Crosse last weekend. The Warhawks won their ninth straight game at home over UW-Stout, 49-0.

* UWW leads the WIAC in scoring offense (37.1) and scoring defense (7.9). UWRF is eighth in scoring offense (12.8) and scoring defense (30.4).

* Falcon punter Jovin Kroll leads the WIAC with a 40.3 average. He had a 68-yard punt against Stout and that is the second longest in the WIAC this season. UWW's Nick Croak is second (39.6). UWRF end Gregg Neumann and UWW's Ryan Kleppe are tied for the WIAC lead in sacks with 7.5. UWW's A.J. Raebel is first (13.5) and Kleppe is second (12.5) in tackles for loss in the WIAC. UWRF end Nathan Renk is tied for the conference lead in fumbles forced (3). UWW quarterback Justin Jacobs is the passing efficiency leader in the WIAC with a 146.2 rating. UWRF's Bruce Baillargeon is tied for first in forced fumbles (4). Whitewater's Jeff Schebler leads the WIAC in scoring with 43 extra points and nine field goals for 70 points.

* This is the 49th meeting between the two teams and Whitewater holds a 26-20-2 lead in the series. UWW has won the past four games. Before that the Falcons had a four-game winning streak.

* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season at UWRF, has a 95-81-3 career record. He is 7-10 against UWW. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins.

* Coach Bob Berezowitz is in his 22nd season at UWW. He announced his retirement in August and today will mark his final regular season game on the sidelines. He has a 154-72-4 career record at UWW. He is third in all-time wins in the WIAC. Berezowitz is 11-10 against River Falls.

River Falls - La Crosse Recap

The Falcon football team fell behind 28-0 and lost at UW-La Crosse, 41-17, Saturday afternoon at Memorial Field.

The Eagles opened up with the first points of the game on an impressive 80-yard 12 play drive which was capped by a Corey Geldernick two-yard touchdown. The drive ate up 4:04 off the clock.

Later in the first quarter, UWL struck again this time putting together a 34-yard three play drive which was capped off by another Geldernick touchdown run this time from nine yards out to make the score 14-0.

The Eagles ended the first quarter in dominating fashion putting together another touchdown drive. The Eagles scored through the air on a 12-yard John Schumann laser to Ted Everson to make the score 21-0 after the first quarter. The drive covered 47 yards and it took six plays.

UWL got the ball back early in the second quarter and they wasted little time getting on the board as they scored two plays later on a 66-yard Dan Hall dash that made the score 28-0. The drive took only two plays and it covered 79 yards.

The Falcons finally got on the board with 4:31 left in the half on a three-yard fourth-and-goal Beau DeBruin touchdown run. The drive covered four yards and it took four plays. The score was set up when Falcon linebacker Dan Buker recovered a UWL fumble at the La Crosse four.

The Eagles answered right back on their next possession going an impressive 83 yards in 12 plays which was capped off by a Dylan Rude 23-yard field goal with only 1:01 left in the half. The drive took 3:20 off the clock. The score at recess was 31-7 Eagles.

The Eagles took the opening possession of the second half and raced down the field going 80 yards in 12 plays which was capped by a Schumann three-yard touchdown run to make the score 38-7.

The Falcons got on the board midway through the third quarter on a 45-yard Spasimir Bodurski field goal. The drive covered five yards and it took four plays. The field goal was set up when Bruce Baillargeon recovered a La Crosse fumble at the UWL 33.

UWL ended the third quarter in style with another scoring drive. They went 41 yards in 10 plays and Rude capped the drive off again with another field goal, this time from 22 yards out, to make the score 41-10 going into the fourth quarter.

RF was the only team to score in the fourth quarter on a 5-yard Jeremy Wolff touchdown. It was an impressive 80-yard 10 play drive and it ate up 4:36 off the clock. That ended the scoring.

The Falcons were led by Wolff and DeBruin as they ran for 59 and 58 yards each and one touchdown apiece. Wolff was 6-10 passing for 62 yards. On defense the Falcons were led once again by Andy Kolstad who had nine solo and 12 total tackles. Baillargeon had nine and Jamie Bisch chipped in with seven total tackles. Buker added five total tackles and one sack.

UWL was led by Geldernick who had 18 carries for 136 yards and two touchdowns. Hall added 95 yards and a score. Schumann was 11-19 in the air for 157 yards and one score.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 95-81-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .539. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is seventh in all-time wins. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.



Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 63-54-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.

Whitewater - Stout Recap

The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater celebrated Bob Berezowitz Day with a 49-0 win over UW-Stout Saturday afternoon in Perkins Stadium.

Berezowitz, who announced his retirement for the end of the 2006-2007 school year, was coaching his last regular season home game. The day was designated Bob Berezowitz Day by Governor James Doyle. Berezowitz, third on the list all-time for football wins in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, raised his record to 153-72-4. The win assures UW-W of at least a share of the WIAC title, with UW-La Crosse one game behind in the standings with just one game left. UW-Whitewater has won 12 consecutive games at home, dating back to Nov. 13, 2004 when UW-La Crosse won 35-10 in Perkins Stadium.

The Warhawk defense has not given up a touchdown since the 5:58 mark in the fourth quarter against UW-Platteville on Oct. 21, a string of 129 minutes. UW-W's defense held UW-Stout to 60 rushing yards on 35 attempts, and the Blue Devils added just 47 yards passing.

Junior linebacker A.J. Raebel had five solo tackles, four assists, three tackles for a loss, and a quarterback sack for UW-W. Fellow linebacker Tristan Borzick, who contributed six tackles, played some "old school" football, also seeing action at fullback where he scored a pair of touchdowns.

UW-W junior halfback Brady Pittz, getting his first start of the season, rushed for 153 yards on 17 carries, his collegiate high for both carries and yards. Coming in to the game Pittz had totaled 11 yards on seven attempts in the first eight games.

Stout running back Ryan Englebart, who came in to the game as the third leading rusher in the WIAC at 99.1 yards per game, was held to 33 yards on 14 carries. Stout QB Tanner Kattre completed 11 of 20 passes for 47 yards. Linebacker Luke Steffen, the leading tackler in the WIAC, led the Blue Devils with 10 tackles and two more for a loss.

UW-Whitewater, 9-0 overall and 6-0 in the WIAC, is ranked second in all three Division III national polls.

has been head football coach at UW-Whitewater since 1985. Some of Berezowitz's accomplishments are WIAC championships won - 1987, 1988, 1990, 1994, 1997, 1998, 2005; WIAC Football Coach of the Year six times - 1987, 1988, 1990, 1994, 1997, 2005; Wisconsin College Coach of the Year 1997 and 2005; American Football Coaches Association Regional Coach of the Year three times - 1988, 1990, 2005; four NCAA playoff appearances - 1988, 1990, 1994, and 2005; culminating in American Football Coaches Association 2005 NCAA Division III Coach of the Year. Berezowitz has been elected to the UW-Whitewater Athletics Hall of Fame, National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics District 14 Hall of Fame, and Wisconsin Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Berezowitz is ranked second in games won among Whitewater football coaches. The 2005 edition of his Warhawks broke thirteen school records, including most victories and best winning percentage. Berezowitz was a standout quarterback during his days with the Warhawks. He still has two school records and is tied for first in two others. He guided the Warhawks to a second place finish in the 1966 NAIA championship, giving him the unique distinction of having played and coached in the national championship game. During his standout year of 1966, Berezowitz was selected Associated Press Small College All-American. Berezowitz continued his football career in the Central United States Football League (semi-professional football), being named the MVP of the league in 1968.

Berezowitz was not only a star quarterback but he was selected as an all-American in baseball as a catcher while at Whitewater. He had opportunities to sign professional baseball contracts but decided to become a coach instead. UW-W football players have earned a total of 58 all-American honors as well as numerous all-conference honors under Berezowitz's tenure. Bob, Stan Zweifel, and Brian Borland wrote a book on Whitewater's zone offense, and he has a videotape on the market dealing with quarterback fundamentals.

UW-RF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 29-22 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 25-16 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-37 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. yards in three plays. Later in the third quarter RF got on the board again this time by Nathan Anderson who ran it in from two-yards out. Affeldt's two-point conversion run was good to make the score 28-16 UWW. The drive covered 75 yards in 17 plays.

UWW scored the only points of the fourth quarter on a Jacobs to Pete Schmitt 21-yard touchdown pass to make the score 35-16. The drive covered 50 yards in nine plays.

RF was led by Anderson's 98 yards rushing and one touchdown. Wolff chipped in with 66 yards running and one passing touchdown. Affeldt led the team with 31 yards receiving and one touchdown.
