- * Both teams picked up wins last weekend. The Falcons won at Pacific Lutheran, 24-17 while SF took a 63-0 win at home over Pikesville.
- * This will be the third straight road game for the Falcons. They have not played a home game yet in 2006. The Cougars opened their season on the road, but are in the middle of a four-game home stand.
- * This is the first meeting ever between the two teams.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season with the Falcons, has a 93-76-3 career record. He is 0-0 against SF. He is a 1979 graduate of UW-RF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He needs two wins to get to No. 7 in all-time wins in the WIAC.

Falcons defeated Pacific Lutheran, 24-17, in a non-conference game played Saturday at Sparks Stadium.

The two teams combining to give the ball away 11 times. The Falcon defense picked off three PLU passes and recovered three fumbles. The Falcons offense lost three fumbles and threw two interceptions.

UW-River Falls turned the ball over on each of its first three possessions and the Lutes scored after two of them.

Taking the ball on the Falcons' 30-yard line following a fumble recovery, the Lutes scored in two plays. Junior quarterback Brett Gordon connected with Craig Chiado on a 21-yard scoring play. It was the first collegiate pass thrown by Gordon. Later in the quarter and following a Brent Frank interception, the Lutes added three points in Pat Burke's 25-yard field goal.

That margin held into the third quarter when a pair of Bruce Baillargeon interceptions on consecutive PLU possessions turned the momentum to the Falcons.

Baillargeon's first interception and 29-yard return gave the Falcons the ball at PLU 20-yard line, and on the next play UW-RF quarterback Jeremy Wolff broke through a tackle and went the distance to cut the Falcons deficit to 10-7. Following the second interception, UW-RF took over at its own 24-yard line. After a one-yard loss, Wolff hit Josh Grover behind the PLU secondary for a 77-yard scoring play. The extra point kick by Spasimir Bodurski gave the Falcons a 14-10 lead.

UW-RF stretched the advantage to 21-10 after Gordon was sacked and fumbled. Nathan Renk recovered at the PLU 8-yard line for the Falcons, who scored three plays later on Wolff's one-yard scoring run. On the ensuing kickoff, PLU ran some trickery on the return when Chase Reed threw across the field to Brent Frank, who raced down the left sideline for an apparent score. The play was called back, however, when it was ruled the Reed's throw was an illegal forward pass.

With 1:41 left in the third period and following PLU's fourth turnover - this a fumble in as many possessions - Bodurski kicked a 42-yard field goal to give the Falcons a 24-10 lead.

The Lutes got back into the game, driving 64 yards on eight plays and scoring early in the fourth period on Gordon's 25-yard pass to Reed. In their final four possessions, however, the Lutes punted twice, threw an interception and turned the ball over on downs.

St. Francis - Pikesville Recap

Shocked and surprised were two adjectives to describe University of Saint Francis coach Kevin Donley's reaction to the final score of his Cougars' 63-0 win at the expense of Pikeville College (KY) on Saturday afternoon.

"They are big and they are fast, very athletic," Donley said looking over the final stats. "We made a great deal of improvement from week 1 to week 2 and that offset that advantage. I'm surprised and pleased.

"It's hard to find much to complain about when you score 63 points and average 8.1 yards a play on offense, but I'm sure we've got more work to do after we break down tapes. We are getting better."

The win was the 80th for the USF football program, all under Donley's guidance. It was also the 31st consecutive win at home for the Cougars (2-0), the 43rd consecutive regular season win, the first shutout in a USF home opening game and the seventh consecutive home opening win.

USF kicked off the PC to open the game and attempted an onside kick, but the Bears recovered to start at their own 40-yard line. PC pushed to the USF 29, but Adam Blakey and Matt Millhouse combined to stop De'von Joseph on fourth and two at the 29. USF drove 71 yards in seven plays, the big play in the drive on a 43-yard scamper by Derrick Alderman. Sophomore halfback Doug Wasylk capped the drive with a 4-yard run with 8:28 to play in the first quarter.

USF added three more touchdowns before halftime -- a 29-yard pass reception from QB Eric Hooks to Alderman, a 30-yard Hooks to Bo Thompson strike and a 6-yard Daniel Carter run. Add in four Cale Grzych extra points and USF led 28-0 at the half.

Carter added a second TD in the fourth quarter turning a short pass from QB Jeff Wedding into a 54-yard touchdown. Two more freshmen got in the scoring act -- Taylor Vieck with a 4-yard run in the third quarter and Marcus Rush with a 17-yard jaunt. Zach Rainey caught a Hooks pass and stepped over a PC defender at the 5-yard line to score and the defense put up six on the board when Vincent Price recovered a blocked punt in the end zone with 10:54 to play in the game.

Alderman rushed for a team-leading 67 yards on just three carries to become the seventh USF back to rush for 1,000 or more yards in his career.

USF won its fifth consecutive game against a Kentucky opponent, scored the most points by a Pikeville opponent and handed the Bears their first shutout since starting the football program in 2001.

Kevin Donley

Kevin Donley, who has established himself as one of the most successful small college football coach's in the country, has taken two different programs to national prominence, won a national championship and national coach of the year honors, begins his eighth season as head football coach at the University of Saint Francis.

Donley led the high-powered Cougars to their sixth straight Mid-States Football Association Mideast League championship and their sixth consecutive NAIA Playoff berth. His Cougars advanced to the NAIA National Championship Game in 2004 in just the seventh season for the program.

Donley, who has been named Mid-States Football Association Coach-of-the-Year five of the last six years, was head coach at Georgetown College for 11 seasons from 1982-92. While at Georgetown, Donley led the Tigers to the 1991 NAIA national championship with a 13-1 record, a season in which he earned NAIA National Coach of the Year honors. Faced with a monumental building process during his tenure with the Tigers, Donley's record was an impressive 77-42 (.647) at Georgetown.

Succeeding with programs that had previously suffered through hard times is nothing new for the Springfield, Ohio native. Prior to taking the head-coaching job at Georgetown, he had four successful seasons at Anderson College. In 1981, he led the Ravens to a 9-2 record and a berth in the NAIA Division II playoffs and Hoosier-Buckeye Collegiate Conference championships in 1980 and 1981.

While at Anderson College, Donley's teams compiled a 28-9 (.757) overall record during his four-year stay. He was named conference coach of the year while at Anderson and Georgetown nine times and is a four-time MSFA Coach-of-the-Year (1999, 2000, 2002, 2003).

Donley-coached teams have had an impressive track record for moving the football through the air and scoring points. Donley's teams have set national offensive records in points per game (59.5), rushing touchdown (69), total touchdowns (102), yards gained per play (7.4), and total offense per game (541.4). His offensive teams have averaged 40.8 points per game. He owns the title of most points scored in a season (744) by any college team in the 20th century at all collegiate levels and earned a display in the College Football Hall of Fame in 1992.

Donley was a linebacker and fullback at Anderson College. He is a 1973 graduate of Anderson College with a Bachelor's Degree in physical education.

In 1976, Donley returned to his alma mater, where he spent the first two seasons as offensive coordinator for the Ravens, and at the age of 26 he was named the youngest head coach in the country while at Anderson.

UW-RF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 27-23 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-15 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-33 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 473-310-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 93-76-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .549. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins. He needs just three wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and

5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 61-50-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.
