The Game

- * The Falcons will try to make it two wins in a row when they host UW-Stout at 1 p.m. at Ramer Field on Saturday.
- * Both teams won for the first time in WIAC play last week. UWRf topped Stevens Point, 20-17 at Ramer Field and Stout won at home over Eau Claire, 14-6.
- * Falcon end Gregg Neumann leads the WIAC with 5.5 sacks and has had at least .5 sacks in three straight games. The Falcons have already eclipsed last year's season total of 12 sacks - the 2006 Falcons have 15. UWRf is second in the WIAC in sacks, trailing only Whitewater (18).
- * Shane Hanson leads the Falcons with three interceptions. With one more interception, Hansen will have more than any Falcon since the 2002 season when Roman Johnson had four.
- * The Falcons play their second straight home game of the 2006 season. This will be the only back-to-back home games this year. The Falcons are 1-1 at home this year and are 12-6 at home against UWS since 1970.
- * This is the 94th meeting between the two teams. UWRf holds a 67-25-1 lead in the all-time series. The longest UWRf winning streak is 17 games from 1922-39. Stout's longest winning streak is five games from 1977-81. UWS has won five of the last six games, including a 38-6 win at home in 2005.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season at UW-RF, has a 94-79-3 career record. He is 10-7 against UWS. He is a 1979 graduate of UW-RF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He needs one win to get to No. 7 in all-time wins in the WIAC.
- * Coach Todd Strop is in his third season at UWS. He has a 14-11 career record and he is 1-1 against UWRf. The University of Wisconsin graduate is 7-10 in WIAC games.

River Falls - Stevens Point Recap

The Falcons made enough big plays on offense and the defense came up big with some big turnovers in a 20-17 victory over Stevens Point Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

In the first quarter neither team could sustain any long drives. The Pointers punted two times and the Falcons once.

Jeremy Wolff gave the Falcons the lead when he scored on the first play of the second quarter on a 4-yard run. It capped off an impressive 14 play, 75-yard drive that took seven minutes off the clock. Add the Spasimir Bodurksi extra point and that made the score 7-0. The touchdown was the first for the Falcons offense in over two games.

After a SP punt, the Falcon offense used the momentum from its last drive when Wolff hooked up with Josh Grover for a 36-yard touchdown pass to make the score 14-0. The drive covered 33 yards in three plays.

SP bounced right back on its next possession going 77 yards in eight plays which was capped off by a 1-yard Cody Childs touchdown run to make the score 14-7.

After a stalled Falcon drive, the Pointers took over at their six-yard line with only 2:11 remaining in the half. They went 88 yards in 12 plays which was capped off by a Ryan Graboski 25-yard field goal as time expired. The score at recess was 14-10 RF.

Josh Grover opened the second half off with a very impressive 48-yard kickoff return to the SP 44-yard line. Wolff completed a 27-yard pass to Jake Jenson down to the SP 17-yard line. Bodurksi capped the drive with another field goal, this time from 25 yards out, to make the score 17-10 RF.

The Falcon special teams came up big in the third quarter with a fumble recovery on a punt return by the Pointers. Ben Arata recovered the fumble and the Falcons took over at the SP nine. The Pointer defense stiffened and Bodurski kicked another field goal, this time from 30 yards out, to make the score 20-10 after the third quarter.

Midway through the fourth quarter the Pointers got back in the game a with crucial 80-yard 10 play drive which was capped off by a Brett Borchart 10-yard touchdown run to pull SP within three points at 20-17. UWSP used a no huddle offense in the drive.

The Falcon defense stepped up big all game and on the Pointers last possession they turned the ball over on downs and the Falcons ran the clock out to pick up their first WIAC win of the season.

For the game, Wolff ran for 121 yards and one touchdown. Throwing the ball he had his best game of the year going 8-16 for 113 yards and one touchdown. Beau DeBruin ran 23 times for 80 yards. Jenson caught four passes for 60 yards. Grover caught two passes for 46 yards and one touchdown.

On defense, the Falcons were led by Bruce Baillargeon who had nine solo and 13 total tackles. Jamie Bisch added eight tackles and Robby Nesvig added seven stops. Nathan Renk added one sack and Gregg Neumann and Ryan Agrimson added half a sack each.

The Pointers were led by Borchart who was 24-40 for 292 yards. Brad Kalsow led the team with eight catches for 93 yards. The Falcons limited Childs to just 44 rushing yards. He was averaging 116 rushing yards entering the contest.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 94-79-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .542. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins. He needs just one win to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 61-52-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.

Stout - Eau Claire Recap

Ryan Englebert uncorked an absolutely fantastic, 31-carry, 134-yard, one-TD rushing showing on a crisp, fall afternoon at Don & Nona Williams Stadium to help catapult the Blue Devils (3-3, 1-2) to a 14-6 homecoming victory over Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference rival UW-Eau Claire (2-4, 1-2).

With the win, Stout snapped a three-game losing streak, picked up its first league win of 2006 and collected its fourth victory over the Blugolds in five years.

Englebert's explosive performance paced a 55-carry, 230-yard rushing outburst for Stout against an Eau Claire defense that entered the contest allowing a mere 77 ground yards per game. Stout headed into the game averaging a WIAC-best 206.4 yards each time out. Englebert picked up his fourth 100-yard rushing game of the year after being limited to double digits in back-to-back games following three straight 100-plus jobs to start the season.

Stout opened the scoring with 9 minutes, 10 seconds elapsed in the opening frame with a 1-yard Tanner Kattre plunge set up by a 6-yard Englebert scamper. Brandon Raciborski tacked on the extra point.

Late in the second stanza, Eau Claire tallied its lone points of the game. With just under four minutes to go, Stout punter Tom Wyngaard saw his punt blocked by the 'Golds' Chris Hull. UWEC's Zach Paul scooped up the pigskin and raced 37 yards to The House, narrowing the gap to 7-6. After a botched snap on the ensuing PAT, Eau Claire failed on advance the fumble into the end zone for a 2-point conversion.

At the 2:13 mark of the fourth quarter, Englebert gave the Blue Devils some breathing room with a 1-yard scoring dive that capped a 15-play, 65-yard Blue Devil drive on which the TD provider tallied 48 rushing yards on 10 totes. Kattre hooked up with WR Shawn Korth for six yards on a key third-and-3 play during that possession.

Eau Claire threw a scare into the Blue Devil faithful on its ensuing possession before the Blue Devils finally put the game on ice. Starting from their own 13, the Blugolds marched to the Stout 33 before a Kyle Paulson pass intended for Matthew Evensen fell harmlessly to the north end zone turf on a fourth-and-12 play that would be Eau Claire's last offensive shot of the game. It was a 48-yard Paulson jaunt on fourth-and-2 from the Eau Claire 21 a bit earlier that made the final ticks interesting.

"We're a fun team to watch," said Stout coach Todd Strop, whose program picked up its 20th victory at Williams Stadium. "We're definitely worth the price of admission."

Stout outgained the Blugolds, 261-259, in net offensive yards. Eau Claire picked up 168 rushing yards, with Edward Kaiser (24 carries-104 yards) becoming the third individual in as many weeks to pick up 100-plus rushing yards vs. Stout.

Andy Reese pitched in 63 rushing yards on 10 carries for Stout, while Kattre added 19 on eight totes and fullback Sam Weber took three handoffs for 11 yards. Kattre completed 4-of-8 passes for 31 yards, with Jesse Wendt snagging two catches for 19 yards.

Todd Strop

Todd Strop begins his third year as the head coach of UW-Stout.

Strop, the team's defensive coordinator for six seasons before becoming the head coach in January, 2004, was the main architect of the defense that has consistently ranked at the top of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) and has found its way into the national rankings several times. The 2002 Blue Devil defense allowed an NCAA Division III low 500 rushing yards, and was ranked 13th in overall defense.

"The head coaching position is a wide encompassing job," Strop said. "The challenge will be having my handprint on all aspects of the program, not just on defense."

Strop's first season started out with a bang as his defense handed him a 23-0 season opening shutout. The Blue Devils finished the season at 5-4 overall.

"I look forward to continue to turning a good program into a great program.," Strop said. "We have many things in place here at Stout - the facilities, high academics, top recruiting classes - to challenge at the national level."

When Strop walked onto the Stout campus seven years ago, he immediately fell in love with the Stout and Menomonie communities. Growing up in nearby Ladysmith, Strop was familiar with Stout and the WIAC.

"Growing up in northwest Wisconsin, these are the dream jobs," Strop said.

"The last two or three recruiting classes have been very good recruiting classes," Strop said. "When I look at the skills positions, we are as good as we have ever been."

"We need to look at a lot of the little things, and do the little things right."

Strop, who was the WIAC assistant coach of the year in 2000, worked specifically with the defensive backs and was the team's recruiting coordinator. Over Strop's tenure, the Blue Devil defense has had five All-America picks and two players that went on to play in the NFL - Jeff Hazuga with the Minnesota Vikings and Tony Beckham, who is currently staring at a starting spot with the Tennessee Titans.

Strop played at Wisconsin from 1987-92 for present coach Barry Alvarez as a defensive back and special teams player. Strop has a special place in his heart for special teams, and wants to put more of an emphasis on that part of Stout's game.

The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-35 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 474-313-49 record in 103 seasons.

The Falcons dodge a couple of early game bullets but lost a 38-6 WIAC game at UW-Stout on Saturday.

Stout took the opening kick off and drove to the Falcon 22 yard line before Andy Acosta intercepted a Stout pass to stop the drive. Later in the quarter Stout drove to the Falcon 16 before Matt Jordan recovered a fumble at the RF 12 to kill that drive.

But just before the first quarter ended the Falcons fumbled and Stout's Stephen Schils returned the ball 22-yards for a score to give his team a 7-0 lead after one quarter.

The Falcons went three and out and Stout took over at their 47. They drove to the Falcon 18 where Evan Larsen kicked a 35-yard field goal to make it a 10-0 game.

The Falcons were forced to punt again on their next possession and Stout scored on a 17-yard run by Andy Reese to take a 17-0 lead. The drive covered 66 yards and took 3:04 off the clock. That was all of the scoring in the first half.

The Blue Devils scored 21 unanswered points in the third quarter.

Jesse Wendt scored on a 15-yard pass play from Tanner Kattre with 8:27 to play in the third quarter. On RF's next possession the Falcons threw an interception that led to another Stout score. Once again it was the Wendt-Kattre combination and the touch-down play covered 10-yards. The Falcons were stopped again after three plays and then Stout's Joe Seep returned the Falcon punt 69-yards for a score.

The Falcons finally got on the scoreboard with 7:41 to play in the game when Nathan Anderson went out. The drive covered 72 yards in 11 plays. The big play in the drive was a 28-yard run by Jeremy Wolff that gave the Falcons a first down at the UWS seven. Three plays later Anderson scored.

Anderson finished with 145 rushing yards to lead the Falcons. Wolff added 42 rushing yards, but finished 0-3 passing with two interceptions.

Shane Hansen led the Falcon defense with eight solo and 11 total tackles. Tony Dorner had one solo and 10 total stops. Ryan Agrimson had four solo and Nathan Renk had seven tackles including one sack.

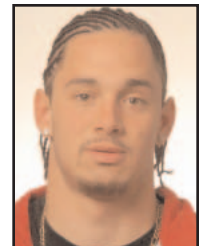
