The Falcons won two more games last week and will take their undefeated record into two more WIAC games this week. UWRF plays at UW-Eau Claire on Wednesday and will host UW-Platteville on Saturday.

UWRF will play for the first time on the road on Wednesday at UWEC... the home court has been good to the Falcons; they are the only undefeated WIAC team with a perfect 5-0 record... the Falcons are tied for first place with La Crosse... UWRF limited Superior to just 33 points last week... the Falcons are a +24.8 in scoring margin... opponents are shooting just 74-237 (.312) from the floor... UWRF received votes in this week's D3Hoops.com poll.

UWEC enters the week with a 5-2 overall and a 1-1 WIAC record... the Blugolds surprised some observers when they defeated Stout (59-44) on Nov. 29... Michelle Burns leads the team in scoring (15.3) with Heidi Arciszewski second (12.3)... Arciszewski earned honorable mention to the 2006 All-WIAC team... Burns leads the team averaging eight rebounds a game... the Blugolds are 4-0 at home... UWEC holds a 42-24 lead in the all-time series... UWEC received votes in this week's D3Hoops.com poll.

UWP starts the week with 4-3 overall and 0-1 WIAC records... UWP plays at La Crosse on Wednesday... Liz Tesch, who earned honorable mention to the 2006 All-WIAC team, leads the Pioneers in scoring (13.6) and is second in rebounding (6.0)... the Pioneers have received balanced scoring with five players averaging in double figures... UWP is 2-1 in road games... UWRF holds a 33-19 advantage in the all-time series.

Cindy Hovet

Head Coach



Cindy Hovet returns to the helm entering her seventh year as the head basketball coach at UW-River Falls with the 2006-07 season.

Hovet works to get the most out of her players both on and off the court. Ten of last season's 12 Falcons earned their way onto the WIAC Scholastic Honor Roll. The Falcons have held their own in competing in the tough Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference that has produced three NCAA champions and two second-place finishers.

She starts the 2006-07 season fourth among active WIAC coaches in wins. She needs just eight wins to move into 13th place in wins among all WIAC coaches. Hovet has coached 12 Falcons to All-WIAC honors and Erin Effle was named the WIAC basketball Scholar-Athlete after the 2004-05 season.

Hovet was inducted into the UW-Stout Athletic Hall of Fame in November 2005. She is the only person who has been named a WIAC Coach of the Year (2001) and WIAC Player of the Year (1994).

The Falcons play another rugged 25-game schedule in 2006-07. UWRF will look to get off to a fast start with the first games at the Karges Center. The Falcons play three MIAC teams to start the season - Hamline, Augsburg and St. Thomas. The Tommies have won more MIAC titles (10) than any other institution. The Falcons open WIAC play on Nov. 29 against Superior and perhaps the biggest game of the early-season schedule will be a home contest against Stevens Point on Dec. 2.

"With five seniors we have a lot of experience and maturity to lead us. This is the strongest senior class I've ever coached and I'm excited about the opportunity they have to put together a really special season," said Hovet.

"Traci (Reimann) and Megan (Lindman) are the toughest post tandem in the league; Krista (Cordes) is versatile and can shoot the lights out; Chan (Melgaard) is a great athlete and competitor and Melanie (Preiner) is one of the best all-around players I've seen. We also have a solid group of young players that will contribute a great deal to our team; they are the future of our basketball program. This team has some great players that are truly exceptional people, I'm proud of them and I couldn't ask for a better group of women to coach this year."

The 2005-06 Falcons had a disappointing 12-14 overall record, but managed to finish 8-8 in the WIAC. The biggest win for the Falcons was a 67-48 victory over Oshkosh at the Karges Center on Jan. 28. Oshkosh finished in a tie for first place in the final WIAC standings.

In 2004-05 the Falcons finished 17-8 overall and 10-6 and in fourth place in the WIAC. The 17 wins and 10 WIAC victories were the second most by a Hovet coached team.

The 2003-04 season concluded with a 13-13 overall record, and 4-12 in the WIAC. Although the team didn't do as well in conference play as they had hoped, they managed to put together a perfect 9-0 non-conference record. That perfect record included impressive victories against two NCAA national tournament qualifiers, Lakeland (22-6) and Maryville (23-3). Both Lakeland and Maryville went undefeated and were champions of their respective conferences.

UWRF finished in sixth place in the WIAC with a 10-15 overall record in 2002-03 and 11-15 in 2001-02. Hovet's first season at the helm for UWRF was the program's most successful since 1988-89. With an 18-8 overall record, they tied for third place in the conference. Hovet was named the WIAC Coach of the Year for the team's accomplishments that season.

Hovet was the UWRF head tennis coach and assistant basketball coach for five years before taking over the basketball program in 2000-01. Her playing career was also in the WIAC. As a student-athlete at UW-Stout she was a two-time All-WIAC first team selection in 1993 and 1994. Her senior season she was named the 1994 WIAC Player of the Year and earned All-American honors. She was named to the second All-WIAC team in 1992. She helped the Blue Devils to a 76-27 record and berths in both the NCAA Division III and NAIA National Tournaments for four seasons.

Hovet received her psychology undergraduate degree and coaching minor from UW-Stout. She completed her Master's Degree in kinesiology with an emphasis in sport psychology and sociology at the University of Minnesota. She currently teaches at UWRF in the health & human performance department along with her coaching duties.

Eau Claire 56, River Falls 32

The Falcons lost a 56-32 WIAC game at UW-Eau Claire Wednesday night at Zorn Arena.

RF was led by Megan Lindman who had eight points, five rebounds and three steals. Krista Cordes also pitched in with five rebounds. Chisato Nakaike led the team with three assists. The Falcons turned the ball over 27 times compared to Eau Claire's 16.

Eau Claire was led by Heidi Arciszewski's 16 point, six rebound performance. Brittanni Hakanson added 10 points. Rachel Becker led the team with eight assists and pitched in with eight points. Amanda Zenner led the team with six steals

UWRF shot a woeful 13-41 (.317) from the field, including just 2-15 (.133) from behind the arc. They were 4-6 (.666) from the line. UWEC shot 24-55 (.436) from the field, and just 4-13 (.308) from three-point range. They were 4-7 (.570) from the line. Eau Claire had more rebounds with a 35-27 advantage.

RF kept it close in the first half after a Miranda Biteler three-pointer tied the game at 15 with 8:48 left. Eau Claire then went on a 9-0 run to make the score 26-17 after a Hakanson jumper with left 3:48 left in the half. RF closed the half with two made baskets to make the score 26-21.

UWEC opened the second half with a 19-2 run that was capped off by a Jen Charboneau jumper to make the score 49-23 EC with 5:53 left in the game. The 32 points is a season low for the Falcons, who are now 1-9 on the road this season.
