The Game

- * The Falcons open the 2007 season on Saturday when they travel to Hope College in Holland, Mich. The non-conference game starts at 1 p.m. (ET).
- * The Falcons haven't won a season-opening game since 1996 when they defeated Winona State, 29-22 on the road. Before that the Falcons had won seven straight season-opening contests.
- * The Falcons are tentatively set to have 13 senior starters against Hope. There are six offensive and seven defensive starters who are seniors. In addition, there are one freshman (offense), five junior (four offense, one defense) and three sophomore (all defense) starters.
- * This is the first meeting ever between the two teams. UWRF has played in Michigan only once before - in 1993 the Falcons won at Alma, 29-7.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 95-82-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins.
- * Coach Dean Kreps is in his 13th year at Hope and has a 67-49 record with the Flying Dutchmen. He is a 1984 graduate of Monmouth College. He has led Hope to five MIAA championships (1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006).

UWRF Season Preview

The Falcon football team opens its season on Saturday and that will give Coach John O'Grady to see his team in action against a quality opponent.

The Falcons play at Hope, Mich., with game time set for 1 p.m. (ET). "Hope has been picked to win their league title. They are a very good team with a lot of speed and quickness - they remind me of St. John's that way. We will be a bigger team than Hope. I think our defense will have to play well since we will have some younger players competing on the offensive side," said O'Grady. Hope won the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic

Conference championship last year and finished with a 7-4 overall record.

The Falcon secondary is a veteran group and will be looked upon to help lead the team. Cornerbacks Shane Hanson and Jamie Bisch started all of last year and third and fourth in tackles last year. Hanson (49 tackles) led the Falcons with five interceptions. Bisch (46 tackles) had one pick. Joe Simonson has been moved from free to strong safety and Ben Arata has taken over at free safety. "Bisch and Hanson are staples in the secondary. Simonson has had a great pre-season and Arata has a lot of speed," said O'Grady.

Gregg Neumann returns at one of the end spots after being named to the 2006 All-WIAC first team. The senior had 37 tackles and led the Falcons with 7.5 sacks. Mike Mueller will be at the other end. Tackles Mike Larson (13 tackles), Sean Wolf (three tackles) and Brad Novacheck will do the work on the inside.

Bruce Baillargeon, who was named to the second All-WIAC team in 2006, will be the leader of the linebackers. He finished second with 84 tackles last year and had two interceptions. Ryan Agrimson (36 tackles) will also be at linebacker.

"We all felt that we needed to improve on defense," said O'Grady. "I know we improved our depth and speed with our recruiting."

The Falcon offensive line is a team strength with several key players back. Scott Witte, who earned honorable mention to the 2006 All-WIAC team will anchor the line at center. Jordan Miller will be at a tackle spot and O'Grady said he has had an outstanding pre-season. Nate Tenut is back at a guard spot and Pete Kolpack returns at tackle. Ryan Hansen, who has also had a great pre-season according to O'Grady, will be at tight end.

Storm Harmon is the No. 1 quarterback. He played in five games last year but has completed only 3-5 for 29 yards in his college career. Senior Nate Anderson will be the top running back. In seven games he led the Falcons with 611 rushing yards.

Josh Grover returns at wide receiver after leading the team with 30 catches for 509 yards and four touchdowns. He has great speed and is a deep threat. O'Grady said that freshman Michael Zweifel has caught nearly every ball thrown to him during camp and will see extended action.

"We're going to throw the ball more and our offense is a little different than last year," said O'Grady. "And, that will take time. Our offensive system is very controlled right now. I think our offense is going to be better and score more points than in 2006." The Falcons scored 131 points in 10 games last year.

O'Grady mentioned that the team's offensive coaches, led by coordinator Andy Kotelnicki, have been doing an excellent job. "I feel we are so much more organized. The players are getting a better feeling and understanding of what we're trying to do."

After this week's game in Michigan, the Falcons will host perennial NCAA power St. John's on Sept. 8 and will be at Ramer Field again on Sept. 15 when they host Pacific Lutheran.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRF and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRF for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRF graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

2007 Hope Preview

The Flying Dutchmen will be hoping to have a season from beginning-to-end that matches the heart of their league championship campaign of a year ago.

In 2006, coach Dean Kreps' Dutchmen lost their first three games, then strung together seven consecutive wins to capture the MIAA title, but made a quick exit from the NCAA playoffs, bowing to the eventual national champion in the first round.

Hope's 2006 accomplishments have caught the attention of the pre-season predictors. The Flying Dutchmen are ranked 19th nationally among Division III teams by Smith and Street's.

The Flying Dutchmen will be seeking an unprecedented 11th consecutive .500 or better season. Over the past decade have averaged six victories a season. The 2006 team was 7-4.

A milestone is in sight for the Flying Dutchmen as they approach Hope's 98th season of playing football; the program is just three victories from Hope's 400th all-time.

The team returns 38 letterwinners. The pre-season roster of 174 players includes 75 freshmen, 51 sophomores, 19 juniors and 29 seniors. There is the potential of having 10 of last year's 11 offensive starters back on the field while the defense faces a bigger rebuilding challenge with just four starters returning from last fall.

Co-captains of the team will be seniors Colin Balas, Troy Blasius, Matt Rugenstein and Kevin VandenBosch.

Six returning players received all-conference honors in 2006 – senior tailback David Booko, senior offensive tackle Jake Droppers, junior offensive tackle Eric Lodomersky, senior tight end Kevin VandenBosch, senior defensive end Matt Rugenstein, senior wide receiver Doug Van Eerden and senior return specialist Joey Goeb.

Matt Rugenstein was named a DIII All-American by Don Hansen's Football Gazette. He was voted the most valuable defensive player in the MIAA and was named a Division III national defensive player of the week after collecting 4.5 quarterback sacks against DePauw. For the season he ranked among the Division III leaders in sacks (#14 with 11.5) and tackles for a loss (#17 with 20.5).

Senior kicking specialist Chris Bowen was the conference special teams player of the week three times in 2006. He averaged 34.8 yards on punts with none blocked, was 29-for-33 in PATS and 6-for-10 on field goals.

Senior tailback David Booko rushed for over 1,000 yards for the second consecutive season and enters the 2007 season ranked second among Hope's all-time leading rusher. He averaged 96.7 yards per game rushing and scored 17 touchdowns, third best in a season for a Hope player.

Seniors Doug Van Eerden and Kevin VandenBosch ranked one-two among Hope's pass receivers in 2006. Van Eerden caught a team leading 45 passes for 800 yards (a 17.8 yards per catch average) and eight touchdowns. VandenBosch caught 35 passes for 392 yards.

Junior quarterback Jake Manning averaged 165 yards a game passing to rank among the leaders in NCAA Division III. He guided an offense that averaged 23.4 points a game.

Return specialist Joey Goeb was among the Division III leaders in punt returns (9.0 yards per return) and kickoff returns (20.7 ypr). He had the distinction of playing on two conference championship teams, first football in the fall and then baseball this past spring.

The pre-season roster includes five sets of brothers – junior Kevin and freshman Kyle Mills; senior Steven and freshman Doug Mostrom, senior Jon and freshman Aaron Szarowicz, senior Kevin and freshman Kyle VandenBosch and junior Andy, freshman Jake and freshman Joe VanderYacht.

The Flying Dutchmen will open the season hosting first-time opponent UW-River Falls on Saturday, Sept. 1 (Labor Day weekend). Hope will play two night game, hosting Central, Iowa on Community Day (Sept. 8) and traveling to Wheaton on Sept. 22.

Dean Kreps is one

of the most successful coaches in the history of America's oldest collegiate athletic conference.

In twelve seasons as head coach he has guided the Flying Dutchmen to five Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) championships (1997, 1999, 2000, 2003 and 2006) while posting a 67-49 overall record and a 52-18 mark in conference games. The team qualified for the NCAA playoffs in 2000, 2003 and 2006.

A member of the Hope faculty since 1986, he is an associate professor of kinesiology. Prior to being named head coach in 1995, he served nine years as a member of the football coaching staff. He was defensive coordinator from 1991-94.

With 67 wins through 12 seasons, Kreps is second winningest coach in Hope football history. Hope has had only six head football coaches since 1917.

When Hope won the 2006 MIAA championship with a perfect 7-0 record, coach Kreps joined an elite group of coaches to win five or more conference football championships during their career. He became just the sixth coach in the 109-year history of the MIAA to accomplish the feat. The others are Ray Smith of Hope (9 titles over 25 seasons from 1970-94); Pete Schmidt of Albion (9 titles over 14 seasons from 1983-96); Frank "Muddy" Waters of Hillsdale (6 titles over 6 seasons from 1954-60); Royal Campbell of Alma (6 titles over 6 seasons from 1921-35); and Morley Fraser of Albion (5 titles over 15 seasons from 1954-68).

An Illinois native, Kreps served as a graduate assistant football coach at the University of Illinois prior to joining the Hope staff. He is a 1984 graduate of Monmouth College in Illinois, where he played football four years -- serving as captain his senior year. He received the master of science degree in athletic administration from the University of Illinois in 1986.

He was active in student activities as a Monmouth undergraduate, receiving the Monmouth College Student Association Award for service to the college community.

His teaching specialty is athletic administration and sports management. Since coming to Hope he has initiated a summer football camp program which annually attracts up to 300 high school athletes. He is active in the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and at the First Presbyterian Church in Holland, where he served as an elder.

The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-37 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play.
