Ramer Field (River Falls, Wis.)

- \* The Falcons return to Ramer Field to host UW-Platteville in a WIAC matchup that starts at 1 p.m.
- \* The Falcons lost a heartbreaking 28-27 WIAC game at UW-Stout last weekend. UWS kicked a 52-yard field goal with just 45 seconds to play to get the win.
- \* This is the 51st meeting between the teams in a series that started in 1923. UWP's 28-10 win in 2006 snapped a UWRF 13 game winning streak.
- \* Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson missed the 100 yard mark for just the second time this year at UWS. He has 19 career 100+ yard rushing games. His career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005. He needs just 98 yards to reach the 1,000 yard mark. Anderson is second in rushing in the WIAC with 902 yards.
- \* Falcon senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon finished with a season-high 25 tackles at Stout. He leads the WIAC in tackles with 105 - 27 more than anyone else. It was the second game in three weeks that he had more than 20 tackles in a game. He had 22 at Whitewater. He also leads the conference in fumbles forced (3).
- \* Falcon senior end Gregg Neumann continues to lead the WIAC in sacks (9.5) and tackles for loss (11.5). He has 20.5 career sacks.
- \* UWRF freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel continues to lead the WIAC in catches (50) and receiving yards (656). The Falcon record for season receiving yards is 778.
- \* Junior quarterback Storm Harmon set the UWRF single season passing record after throwing for 235 yards at Stout. He has thrown for 1,517 yards this year. He now has tied or broke four UWRF passing records. Against Pacific Lutheran he was 26-49 which set records for completions and attempts in a game. Against Hope he threw four touchdown passes which tied the school record. The Falcon record for yards in a season was 1,506.
- \* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 97-87-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 14-3-1 against Platteville.

- \* After Saturday's game against Platteville the Falcons stay at Ramer Field to host UW-La Crosse on Nov. 3. Action starts at 1 p.m.

## Stout 28, River Falls 27

A 52-yard field goal with 45 seconds left in the game was the difference as UW-Stout defeated the Falcons, 28-27, Saturday afternoon in Menomonie.

The kicking games literally made the difference in the contest. The Falcons missed an extra point with 10:04 left in the game, leaving them ahead by two points. After RF called timeout to ice the kicker, ST's junior kicker Brandon Raciborski nailed the 52-yarder that sealed the Falcons' fate.

The contest was back and forth all day. Both teams began the first quarter with drives deep into the opponents' territory, only to have both of the drives end with interceptions.

Stout quarterback Tanner Kattre had driven the Blue Devils down to the RF 14 yard line before senior defensive back Joe Simonson intercepted a pass in the end zone.

RF went three-and-out on the ensuing possession and, after a return of 19 yards, Stout began its drive at the RF 46 yard line. The Blue Devils drove down to the RF 20 yard line when running back Andy Reese scampered 20 yards for the first score of the game, capping a 7-play, 46-yard drive. The Blue Devils converted a two-point try and led 8-0.

After the ensuing kickoff RF started on its own 14 yard line. Junior quarterback Storm Harmon completed consecutive passes of 10 yards to freshman wide receiver MJ Bland, and 27 yards to freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel. The Falcons drove all the way down to the UWS one yard line where, on fourth down, Harmon snuck the final yard for a touchdown capping a 12-play, 86-yard drive. The Falcons were unsuccessful on the two-point conversion attempt, leaving the score 8-6.

RF regained possession on the second play of the next Stout drive when senior defensive back Jamie Bisch recovered a Kyle Provos fumble on the Blue Devil 24 yard line.

On the first play of the second quarter Harmon ended a drive that began with the fumble recovery by throwing a 22-yard touchdown strike to sophomore tight end Ryan Hansen, that made the score 13-8 after the point after kick.

Stout responded by completing passes of 23 and 24 yards on the next drive. The drive stalled at the RF 22 yard line resulting in a 39-yard field goal from kicker Kyle Martin, capping the 9-play, 63-yard drive, and bringing Stout within two at 13-11.

UWS forced the Falcons to punt on their next possession and started its next drive on their 28 yard line with 10:36 remaining in the second quarter. The ensuing drive featured rushes of 22 yards by Kattre and 36 yards by Shawn Korth before Reese punched it in from the RF three yard line to put the Blue Devils ahead 18-13.

RF did get one more chance in the first half after a Reese fumble was recovered by sophomore defensive back Ben Arata on the Stout 15. But senior running back Nathan Anderson was stopped short of the first down on fourth-and-one from the six yard line, forcing the Falcons to turn the ball over on downs.

After RF began the third quarter by missing a 33-yard field goal, the offense quickly got another chance after senior linebacker Ryan Agrimson intercepted a Kattre pass on the next play from scrimmage, and returned it to the UWS four yard line.

The RF offense wasted no time with freshman running back Matt Pollock running it in from the four yard line on the first play of the drive putting RF back on top, 21-18.

After trading a couple of punts, the third quarter ended with the Falcons ahead by three.

The RF lead lasted only three minutes into the fourth quarter after Reese capped a 13-play, 79-yard drive with a two-yard touchdown run putting his team ahead 25-21.

RF quickly took the lead back on a four-play, 80-yard drive, capped by Pollock's second touchdown of the day. The touchdown run was set up by a 71-yard bomb from Harmon to freshman wide receiver Nate Thoreson.

But after going ahead with the touchdown, RF made what would be a costly mistake, by missing the point after kick, keeping RF ahead by two, 27-25.

UWS couldn't capitalize on the next drive by missing a 37-yard field goal that would have put them ahead. But after RF went three-and-out on its possession, the Blue Devils started the game's definitive drive on its own 42 yard line with 2:27 left.

## Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRP and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRP in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRP students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRP graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRP for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRP graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

## Eau Claire 40, Platteville 33

UW-Eau Claire converted six UW-Platteville turnovers into a 40-33 victory Saturday in Carson Park.

Two UWP fumbles led to a quick 13-0 Blugold lead, on a 10-yard pass from Mitch Schaeuble to Chris Hull and a nine-yard Cory Sartorelli run. The Pioneers tied the score on a two-yard pass from John Akim to lineman Elliott Wolf, lined up in a tight end formation, and a Mike Genslinger one-yard scoring run.

Craig Polikfka gave the Blugolds the first of two defensive scores, returning an interception 43 yards for a score. After UWEC took a 27-16 halftime lead, Mitch Ebner returned another interception 31 yards for a touchdown.

Genslinger scored from two yards out, and Tony Smidl kicked a 35-yard field goal, narrowing the deficit to 34-26. Craig Kolb answered with two fourth-quarter field goals for a 40-26 advantage. Akim hit Dan Schwartz with a 17-yard touchdown pass with 30 seconds left, but the Blugolds recovered the on-sides kick and ran out the clock.

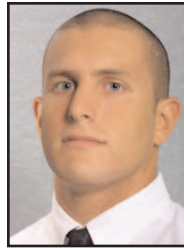
The Blugolds improved to 6-2 overall and 3-2 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, while the Pioneers fell to 2-5, 1-3.

The Pioneers out-gained the Blugolds 361-254, but lost the two fumbles and four interceptions.

Genslinger rushed for 69 yards, and Joe Burkeland 62, while Akim threw for 221 yards and Schwartz caught five passes for 108 yards for the Pioneers, who ran up more than 30 points for the third straight week.

Sartorelli rushed for 119 yards to lead the Blugolds, who committed four turnovers.

UWP's David Pietrowiak, Ben Lusted and Brandon Willger each made interceptions, while Chris Booze recovered a fumble. Both Booze and Justin Athey made three tackles for loss, while David Akey blocked a kick for the third straight week.

**Emendorfer** has

restored the winning tradition at UW-Platteville.

Emendorfer, the 2004 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year, has guided the Pioneers to .500 seasons or better in two of the last three seasons.

In his eight years, Emendorfer has guided the Pioneers to the most explosive offensive era in the 108-year history of the UWP football program.

The Pioneers have rewritten the record books, establishing 26 school records and breaking 10 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference marks. In addition, Emendorfer's teams have produced 45 all-conference players, two all-Americans, six academic all-district selections and a WIAC Scholar-Athlete winner. The Pioneers have ranked among the nation's passing leaders in four of the last five years. In 2006, the Pioneers unleashed a powerful running game that produced the first 1,000-yard rusher in 12 years.

The 2006 team finished 5-5, bouncing back from an injury-filled 2005. Last year's Pioneers were 2-0 in non-conference games against NCAA III teams, including a 24-7 win over nationally ranked Augustana (Ill.). The Pioneers also registered their first WIAC road win since 2001 and beat UW-River Falls for the first time since 1992.

Because of injuries, 40 different players started at least once for the 2005 Pioneers, who struggled to a 1-9 mark. The bright side, however, is that Emendorfer returns a vast array of talent and experience to bring the Pioneers back to the level of play they had the previous year.

Emendorfer earned the WIAC Coach of the Year Award for 2004, a season in which the Pioneers achieved their first winning record since 1992.

The Pioneers finished 6-4, beating top-20 teams Augustana, UW-Whitewater and UW-Eau Claire. Emendorfer also took his team out to Pennsylvania, where the Pioneers beat Thiel 40-14. Along the way, the team toured Notre Dame and its stadium as well as the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

### UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 30-25 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 25-18 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

### UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 28-40 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

### UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

# Last Season

## Platteville 28, River Falls 10

The Falcons fell to UW-Platteville 28-10 Saturday afternoon at Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium.

Midway through the first quarter RF turned the ball over on a Jeremy Wolff interception that set up UWP's first points of the game. Hans Christiansen returned the pick 12 yards to the UWP 22-yard line. Seven plays later Mike Genslinger scored from one-yard out to make the score 7-0 UWP. The drive went 78 yards and ate 2:01 off the clock.

Early in the second quarter, RF put together an impressive 16 play 75-yard drive which was capped off by a 27-yard Spasimir Bodurksi field goal to make the score 7-3. The drive took 7:37 off the clock.

UWP answered right back later in the quarter with an equally impressive drive that went 66 yards in 13 plays which was capped off by another Genslinger one-yard touchdown. The drive took 4:52 off the clock.

RF got on the board just before half on a Wolff three-yard touchdown run to make the score 14-10 at recess. The drive went 73 yards in 13 plays and took 3:55.

Genslinger dominated the second half with two touchdown runs. The first came with 6:18 left in the game from eight-yards out. The drive covered 89 yards in eight plays and ate up 3:34.

After another Wolff interception the Pioneers wasted little time in scoring. Genslinger burst up the middle for an impressive 69-yard touchdown run to make the score 28-10 UWP. That ended the scoring.

RF could not muster up any big plays or long drives in the second half as they failed to find paydirt.

The Falcons were led by Wolff who ran for 142 yards and one score. He was 5-14 passing for 66 yards and three interceptions. Beau DeBruin ran for 125 yards on 36 carries.

The Pioneers were led by Genslinger who ran for 286 yards on 26 carries and scored four touchdowns. Brent Nelson threw for 105 yards on 9-20 throwing. He also had two interceptions.

On defense the Falcons were led by Nathan Renk who had nine solo and 10 total tackles. Andy Kolstad had seven tackles and Ben Arata added five tackles and one interception. Shane Hanson also had an interception.
