### The Game

- \* The Falcons go on the road for the second time this season on Saturday when they open WIAC play at UW-Stevens Point.
- \* UWRF lost a 48-37 decision at Ramer Field to Pacific Lutheran on Sept. 15. UWSP has started the season with three straight wins, including a 55-0 thumping of Waldorf last week-end at home. The Pointers have allowed only 20 points this year.
- \* This is the 67th meeting between the teams and UWRF has a 36-27-3 lead in the series. Each team has won on its home field in the last three years.
- \* Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson had his second best rushing day in the team's 48-37 loss to Pacific Lutheran. He carried the ball 39 times for 203 yards. That was his 16th career game rushing for more than 100 yards. It was the third time he went over the 200 yard mark - his career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005.
- \* After not turning the ball over in the first game, the Falcon offense had multiple turnovers in the past two games. Against St. John's the Falcons lost four (three interceptions, one fumble) and against Pacific Lutheran they lost three (two interceptions, one fumble). In both games an interception was returned for a touchdown.
- \* Junior quarterback Storm Harmon has already tied or broke three UWRF passing records this year. Against Pacific Lutheran he was 26-49 which set records for completions and attempts in a game. Against Hope he threw four touchdown passes which tied the school record. He has thrown for 810 yards this season and the Falcon record is 1,506.
- \* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 96-84-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 9-9 against UWSP.

- \* After Saturday's game at Stevens Point the Falcons go on the road against on Oct. 6 when they play at UW-Whitewater. The kick off is set for 1 p.m.

## Pacific Lutheran 48, River Falls 37

The Falcons were unable to overcome giving up 28 first quarter points to Pacific Lutheran University losing 48-37 at Ramer Field.

RF outscored PLU 30-20 over the final three quarters but the difference was in the first quarter when the RF defense gave up more than 200 yards of total offense to PLU.

PLU drove 63 yards in eight plays on their first drive to take a 7-0 lead with 11:01 left in the first quarter. RF's first play after that was a 17-yard pass from junior quarterback Storm Harmon to freshman wide-out MJ Bland, who then fumbled and PLU recovered. But PLU's drive stalled on its own 37 yard line.

RF then appeared to gain some momentum, driving 67-yards in 10-plays that included a 4-yard Harmon touchdown pass to junior tight end Ryan Hansen for the first of his two touchdown catches on the day, with 4:47 left in the first quarter. RF recovered a PLU fumble on the next kickoff and started its next drive at the PLU 22-yard line. After gaining just two yards however, junior kicker Jesse Finer missed a 37-yard field goal attempt.

PLU took the ball and proceeded to drive 80 yards in three plays, ending the drive with a 30-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Brett Gordon to wide-receiver Craig Chiado. After RF went three-and-out on its next possession Gordon, connected on a pass for 48 yards, and then two plays later, a touchdown pass of 11 yards, in a drive that lasted only three plays and 34 seconds.

With a commanding 21-7 lead the PLU offense was done for the quarter, but the defense was not, and on the third play of the ensuing RF drive PLU cornerback Jeff Ebel stepped in front of a Harmon pass and returned it 39-yards capping a first quarter that saw 35 points and 325 total offensive yards between the two teams.

RF showed determination all day and started the second and third quarters with touchdown drives. To start the second quarter RF went 64 yards in six plays, ending with a 16-yard Harmon to Ryan Hansen connection, for Hansen's second touchdown of the day, RF missed the extra point try. RF added a field goal and PLU added a touchdown and both teams went into halftime with PLU owning a 34-16 lead.

Even with a better second quarter, the RF defense was dominated in the first half, giving up 292 yards of total offense to PLU and nearly 10 yards per play.

The RF offense, trying to keep pace with PLU, gained 271 yards in the first half. Harmon was 15-26 passing for 194 yards and two touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel had 78 of his 116 receiving yards in the first half, and senior running back Nathan Anderson had 90 of his season-high 203 rushing yards in the first half.

But even with the enormous yardage totals RF found itself down by 18 points due to sub-par defensive play, and the mistakes of a missed field goal, missed extra point and an interception returned for a touchdown.

The efficient PLU offense continued to click as they opened the second half with a 61-yard touchdown drive that lasted only 2:11. After the next RF drive stalled near midfield, the next PLU offensive possession ended with a lost fumble on its 10 yard line. RF handed the ball to Anderson three consecutive times, the final one being a touchdown run of one yard.

After capitalizing on one of the few PLU mistakes of the day, RF found itself down, but not out of the contest, trailing PLU 41-24 at the end of the third quarter.

## Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRP and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRP in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRP students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRP graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRP for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRP graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

## Stevens Point 55, Waldorf 0

For the second straight week, UW-Stevens Point jumped out to an early lead in cruising to its seventh straight win with a 55-0 victory over Waldorf on Saturday at Goerke Field in Stevens Point.

The Pointers scored 38 points in the first half and now have outscored their past two opponents 79-0 in the first half after leading Iowa Wesleyan 41-0 last week.

Early in the first quarter, the Pointers' Matt Lunder recovered a fumble on the Waldorf one-yard line, setting up the first of four touchdown runs by Mike Ferron. The sophomore finished the day with 19 carries for 125 yards and left the game after his fourth touchdown put the Pointers ahead 52-0 with 11:55 left in the third quarter.

Pointers' quarterback Jake Swank also had a big day, completing his first nine passes and finishing 15-for-16 for 173 yards and two touchdowns. His first scoring pass came on the next drive when Jared Jenkins made a diving catch in the corner of the endzone on a third down play. Jenkins finished the day with four receptions for 48 yards.

Pointers' defensive back Kasey Morgan had UW-Stevens Point's first of five interceptions on Waldorf's first possession of the second quarter. Swank then hooked up with wide receiver Brad Kalsow for 43 yards down to the one-yard line. Ferron capped off the drive with a one-yard run.

Swank found Kalsow again for a four-yard touchdown to make the score 28-0 with 7:01 remaining in the second quarter. Kalsow had five catches for 90 yards.

Ferron added a six-yard touchdown and Ryan Graboski made a 19-yard field goal as time expired in the first half for a 38-0 lead.

Pointers' linebacker Brian Bailey intercepted a Ryan Kerns' pass and returned it 11 yards for touchdown on the third play of the second half. The Pointers' again held Waldorf to three-and-out on its next possession and on the first play of the ensuing possession, Ferron rolled 26 yards for his fourth and final touchdown.

The Pointers' final points of the game were scored when kicker Ryan Graboski kicked a 36-yard field goal to make the score 55-0 with 14:50 left in the fourth quarter. Graboski made all extra seven extra points and two field goals for a total of 13 points in the game, tying a school record held by Fred Galecke and Kim Drake for most points by a kicker in a game.

The Pointers' finished the game with 25 first downs and 434 yards of total offense. The UW-Stevens Point defense forced six turnovers and now has 17 takeaways for the year.

## John Meich

has more than twice as many victories as any other coach in school history with a 123-66-2 record, tying for fourth on the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference all-time wins list.



Miech, having completed his 25th year with the coaching staff, has posted 21 seasons with a .500 or better record during the last 23 years. He has won three WIAC championships and earned the WIAC Coach of the Year award in 1998 and 2001. Miech led the Pointers to a 6-4 record and 4-3 league mark in 2006 as the Pointers recovered from a tough early-season schedule to win their last four games.

Miech's association with Pointer football actually goes back to 1972 when he first joined the program as an offensive lineman, providing protection for the nation's top passing offense in both 1973 and 1974.

Along the way, he has developed numerous players who went on to play in the NFL, CFL, AFL and European leagues. Most notable among those players is Clint Kriewaldt, who was drafted in the sixth round by the Detroit Lions in 1999 and played in the 2006 Super Bowl as a member of the world champion Pittsburgh Steelers. Others include Barry Rose, who had stints with both the Buffalo Bills and Denver Broncos, Kirk Baumgartner, a draft choice of the Green Bay Packers and Pete Lucas, a draft pick by the Atlanta Falcons.

In 1975, following graduation with a degree in Physical Education, Miech began his coaching career with a three-year stint as an assistant with the Pointers before moving on to Stephen F. Austin State University. There, he served as a graduate assistant for the Lumberjacks while working on his Master's Degree, which he received in 1979.

Miech returned to Wisconsin in 1979 and served as the head coach at Whitnall High School and then Jefferson High School for three seasons each before returning to UW-Stevens Point in 1985 as the defensive coordinator. As defensive coordinator with the Pointers, his unit allowed just over 275 yards per game and four yards per play in three seasons to lead the conference.

Miech and his wife, Sheila, who serves as the head coach of the highly-successful Pointer women's soccer program, have two sons, Jesse and Ryan.

# Last Season

## RIVER FALLS 20, STEVENS POINT 17

The Falcons made enough big plays on offense and the defense came up big with some big turnovers in a 20-17 victory over Stevens Point Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

In the first quarter neither team could sustain any long drives. The Pointers punted two times and the Falcons once.

Jeremy Wolff gave the Falcons the lead when he scored on the first play of the second quarter on a 4-yard run. It capped off an impressive 14 play, 75-yard drive that took seven minutes off the clock. Add the Spasimir Bodurski extra point and that made the score 7-0. The touchdown was the first for the Falcons offense in over two games.

After a SP punt, the Falcon offense used the momentum from its last drive when Wolff hooked up with Josh Grover for a 36-yard touchdown pass to make the score 14-0. The drive covered 33 yards in three plays.

SP bounced right back on its next possession going 77 yards in eight plays which was capped off by a 1-yard Cody Childs touchdown run to make the score 14-7.

After a stalled Falcon drive, the Pointers took over at their six-yard line with only 2:11 remaining in the half. They went 88 yards

in 12 plays which was capped off by a Ryan Graboski 25-yard field goal as time expired. The score at recess was 14-10 RF.

Josh Grover opened the second half off with a very impressive 48-yard kickoff return to the SP 44-yard line. Wolff completed a 27-yard pass to Jake Jenson down to the SP 17-yard line. Bodurski capped the drive with another field goal, this time from 25 yards out, to make the score 17-10 RF.

The Falcon special teams came up big in the third quarter with a fumble recovery on a punt return by the Pointers. Ben Arata recovered the fumble and the Falcons took over at the SP nine. The Pointer defense stiffened and Bodurski kicked another field goal, this time from 30 yards out, to make the score 20-10 after the third quarter.

Midway through the fourth quarter the Pointers got back in the game with crucial 80-yard 10 play drive which was capped off by a Brett Borchart 10-yard touchdown run to pull SP within three points at 20-17. UWSP used a no huddle offense throughout the drive.

The Falcon defense stepped up big all game and on the Pointers last possession they turned the ball over on downs and the Falcons ran the clock out to pick up their first WIAC win of the season.
