- * The Falcons go back on the road, to UW-Stout, for a WIAC game at Nelson Field. Kick off is set for 1 p.m.
- * The Falcons won a 27-20 decision over Eau Claire at Ramer Field last Saturday. The Falcons trailed, 7-0, but scored 21 points to take the lead. UWEC got back to within 21-20, but the Falcons were able to hold on for their first win at Ramer Field this season.
- * This is the 93rd meeting between the teams and the Falcons hold a 66-26 lead in the series. The Falcons won last year's game, 24-20, at Ramer Field.
- * Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson did it again - he rushed for over 100 yards for the 19th time in his career. He carried the ball 33 times for 124 yards and scored on an 8-yard run. He has gone over the 100 yard mark in five of the team's six games this year. His career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005. He is second in rushing in the WIAC with 813 yards.
- * Falcon senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon leads the WIAC in tackles with 80. He had 22 at Whitewater two weeks ago and came back with 16 against Eau Claire. He also leads the conference in fumbles forced (3).
- * Falcon senior end Gregg Neumann continues to lead the WIAC in sacks (9.5) and tackles for loss (10.5). He has 20.5 career sacks.
- * UWRF freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel continues to lead the WIAC in catches (44). He is second in yards (583) and touchdowns (5). The Falcon record for season receiving yards is 778.
- * Junior quarterback Storm Harmon is getting closer to the UWRF single season passing record. He has thrown for 1,282 yards this year. He has already tied or broke three UWRF passing records. Against Pacific Lutheran he was 26-49 which set records for completions and attempts in a game. Against Hope he threw four touchdown passes which tied the school record. The Falcon record for yards in a season is 1,506.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 97-86-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 11-7 against Stout.

- * After Saturday's game against Stout the Falcons host Platteville on Oct. 27. Kick off is slated for 1 p.m.

River Falls 27, Eau Claire 20

The Falcons scored 10 points off three UW-Eau Claire first half turnovers as the UWRF ended their four game losing streak, and five game losing streak to EC, by upsetting the No. 16 Blugolds 27-20 Saturday for their first home win of the year.

EC fumbled the opening kickoff at its own 36 yard line. But after the ensuing RF drive stalled they couldn't capitalize and missed a 47-yard field goal attempt.

EC then took the ball and ran it seven consecutive times for 48 yards down to the RF 22 yard line. From there EC quarterback Mitch Schaeuble connected with wide receiver Chris Hull for a 22-yard touchdown pass, taking a 7-0 lead at 10:19 of the first quarter.

After RF had their next drive stall at its own 28 yard line EC fumbled the RF punt and the Falcon offense went right back to work at the EC 37 yard line. From there they went 25 yards on eight plays down to the EC 12 yard line before settling for a 30-yard junior kicker Jesse Finer field goal, bringing the score to 7-3 with 3:33 left in the first quarter.

After EC went three-and-out on its next possession RF marched down to the EC 17 yard line before junior quarterback Storm Harmon had a pass intercepted by EC cornerback Kyle Meulemans on the first play of the second quarter.

EC went three-and-out again and RF regained possession on its own 36 yard line. On the second play of the drive Harmon completed a 27-yard pass to freshman wide receiver Nate Thorseon that set up a 41-yard Finer field goal that made the score 7-6 at the 10:45 mark of the second quarter.

EC committed its third turnover of the game on its next possession when Schaeuble fumbled on his own 25 yard line. The Falcons were finally able to capitalize on a Blugold turnover when senior running back Nathan Anderson gained all 25 yards of the next possession including an eight-yard scamper for a touchdown that put the Falcons ahead 12-7. Harmon connected with junior tight end Connor Graves for the two-point conversion that made the score 14-7 with 8:10 left in the first half.

The first half would end that way after sophomore defensive back Ben Arata intercepted a Schaeuble pass in the RF end zone and returned it out to the RF 44 yard line with 1:26 left in the half. The Falcons only made it three plays on their next possession when Harmon had a pass intercepted at the EC 32 yard line with :46 left in the half.

At the half the Falcons led 14-7 in an evenly matched game. RF not only had a slight edge in the score but they out-gained the Blugolds 163 to 131 total yards and had a 1:46 edge in time of possession. The difference was the 11 RF points off of the four first half EC turnovers.

The two teams each punted twice to begin the third quarter. Nine minutes into the quarter RF began its third possession of the second half at its own 37 yard line. After a one-yard Anderson rush, Harmon completed a 28-yard strike to Thorseon, identical to the first half connection that went for 27 yards, down to the EC 35 yard line. Four plays later from the EC 20 yard line, Harmon scrambled for a 20-yard touchdown run that capped the seven-play, 64-yard drive, putting RF ahead 21-7.

The 14-point lead lasted only 18 seconds. On the second play of the ensuing EC drive Schaeuble connected with Hull for a 63-yard touchdown pass, bringing the score to 21-14 with 2:42 left in the third quarter.

The Falcons were able to run off 1:19 of the fourth quarter with a drive that began in the third quarter before punting from the EC 33 yard line.

EC drove to midfield before the drive stalled and were forced to punt pinning the Falcons back at their own 12 yard line. RF drove the ball to midfield and chewed up five minutes of the fourth quarter before punting giving the Blugolds the ball at their own 34 yard line with 6:22 left in the game.

EC converted two fourth downs on its next drive that was capped by a 24-yard touchdown pass from Schaeuble to Spencer Kehoe with 1:33 left in the game, pulling the Blugolds to within one point. But RF's senior lineman Nathan Tenut blocked the extra point kick attempt forcing the Blugolds to attempt an onside kick with just over a minute left in the game.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRP and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRP in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRP students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRP graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRP for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRP graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

Stevens Point 26, Stout 23

UW-Stevens Point ran their conference winning streak to seven games by edging UW-Stout, 26-23, Saturday at Goerke Field.

The Pointers have won all seven of those games by three points or less and the Blue Devils were on the receiving end of one of those close games last season, losing 20-19 in Menomonie.

Stout's Stephen Schills got his first of two interceptions of the day on Stevens Point's first drive. That interception, returned to Stevens Point's four yard line, gave the Blue Devils prime field position. On the first play of the ensuing drive, Tanner Kattre hooked up with Patrick Mengelkoch for a four-yard touchdown, giving Stout the early 7-0 lead.

In the second quarter, Stout (2-4, 1-2) was threatening to increase their lead as they drove deep into Stevens Point territory. That drive, however, came to a screeching halt when a Kyle Provos pass was intercepted by Luke Frisch at the 10 yard line.

Later in the quarter, Stevens Point (6-0, 3-0) was able to put up six points of their own on two of Ryan Graboski's four field goals on the day, to close to within 7-6 at halftime.

On their first possession of the second half, Pointers quarterback Jake Swank completed five out of six pass attempts, leading his team to a third Graboski's field goal, and their first lead of the game, 9-7, at 10:58 in the third quarter.

On the next Stout possession, a Kyle Martin 42-yard punt out of bounds at the Stevens Point three yard line put the Pointers' backs against the wall. On Stevens Point's first play of that drive, Kyle Seiler sacked Swank in the end zone for a safety, tying the game up at nine apiece.

Stout took advantage of the safety by marching 64 yards down the field - 29 yards came on a reception by Dan Lytle from Provos and 15 on a Pointer pass interference - on the ensuing possession, setting up a one-yard touchdown run by Andy Reese, putting Stout up a touchdown.

The Pointers matched that touchdown when Swank hit a wide open David Hammer for 17 yards and the score. A successful extra point tied the game up at 16.

After a Stout three and out, Stevens Point quickly drove down the field again, going 82 yards in just over three minutes, scoring on a Mike Ferron 10-yard touchdown scamper.

Stout was not ready to give up yet. On their next possession, quarterback Kyle Provos took advantage of a blown coverage and hooked up with Eric Cieslak (Fr, Rochester, Minn) for the game-tying score with 2:11 left in the game.

On the ensuing kickoff, Kasey Morgan broke free, returning the ball to the Stout 28 yard line, putting his team in field goal range with under a minute to play. Needing not much more than a few short runs to win the game, Stevens Point nearly turned the ball over twice. One interception was called back due to defensive pass interference, and the other was ruled caught out of bounds by the Stout defender. In the end, however, Graboski kicked his school record tying fourth field goal of the game, leaving just 16 seconds for Stout to score. Stout was not able to muster up anything of a comeback, losing the close game 26-23.

Stevens Point gathered 387 total yards of offense, 221 through the air, 166 on the ground. Swank completed 21-of-41 passes for all of the yardage, a touchdown pass and was picked off twice by Stout's Schills. Brad Kalsow hauled in seven catches for 102 yards. Mike Ferron was the Pointers' leading rusher with 72 yards on 32 carries.

Provos completed 6-of-11 passes for 129 yards and the TD to Cieslak. Kattre completed was 4-for-10 for 25 yards, with the TD pass to Mengelkoch. Kattre was held to 23 yards rushing, had two receptions for 20 yards and averaged 34.5 yards on two punts. Reese led all rushers with 74 yards on 24 carries and caught four passes for 34 yards.

Seiler finished with 11 tackles, eight solo Dustin Robinson had 12 tackles, nine solo, to lead Stevens Point.

Last Season

River Falls 24, Stout 20

The Falcons picked up a dramatic 24-20 victory over Stout Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

Stout opened the game up quickly on the opening drive of the game going 80 yards in five plays, which was capped off by a 24-yard Tanner Kattre run to make the score 7-0 Stout.

In the second quarter, the Blue Devils took over at their own 33-yard and drove the ball all the way down to the Falcon eight-yard line, but the drive stalled and Brandon Raciborski kicked a 25-yard field goal to give UWS a 10-0 lead with 9:34 left in the first half.

RF finally got on the board on their next possession going 80 yards in nine plays, which was capped off by a 3-yard Beau DeBruin touchdown run to make the score 10-7. The key play of the drive was a 28-yard Jeremy Wolff to Josh Grover pass on a second-and-five play from the UWRF 25.

After a 28-yard Jovin Kroll punt, the Blue Devils set up shop at the RF 43-yard line with only 1:17 left in the half. They moved the ball quickly and got all the way down to the Falcon 25-yard line with only 31 seconds to play. The drive stalled and Raciborski connected on a 42-yard field goal to make the score 13-7 Stout at recess.

Midway through the third quarter the Blue Devils forced a Nathan Anderson fumble at the Falcon 26-yard line. Stout scored on the next play going through the air this time with a 26-yard Kattre to Jesse Wendt pass to take a commanding 20-7 lead with 3:54 to play in the third quarter.

To begin the fourth quarter the Falcons set up shop at their own 15-yard line. After a heavy dose of Anderson the Falcons moved the ball all the way down to the Stout one-yard line. After failing three times to punch it in the end zone the Falcons decided to go for it on fourth down and Wolff came through with a 1-yard quarterback sneak for the touchdown to make the score 20-14 Stout.

Later in the fourth quarter, with only 4:08 left in the game, Stout lined up to punt and the Falcon special teams came up big with a Bruce Baillargeon blocked punt. The punt rolled out of bounds at the Stout two and the Falcons scored one play later with a two-yard Wolff plunge to make the score 21-20.

On the ensuing kickoff Mike Mueller forced a Stout fumble that Ben Arata recovered at the Stout 18 with 3:41 to play. UWRF moved the ball five yards in four plays and Spasimir Bodurski kicked a 35-yard field goal to give the Falcons a 24-20 lead with 2:58 to play. The field goal forced Stout to have to move the ball all the way for a touchdown.
