The Game

- * The Falcons travel to UW-Whitewater for a game against the No. 3 ranked team in the nation on Saturday.
- * UWRF lost a 45-42 decision at UW-Stevens Point on Saturday to open WIAC play. UWW came from behind to beat No. 6 ranked La Crosse, 35-28.
- * This is the 50th meeting between the two teams. UWW holds a 27-20-2 advantage in the series that started in 1914. Whitewater has won five straight games.
- * The Falcons have had eight turnovers in the past three games - all losses. The Falcons have had a pass interception returned for a touchdown in each of the three losses. The Falcon defense has come up with eight turnovers.
- * Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson had his 17th career game rushing for more than 100 yards at Stevens Point. He carried the ball 38 times for 141 yards and two touchdowns. His career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005. He is third in the WIAC in rushing yards.
- * Falcon senior defensive end Gregg Neumann set a UWRF single game record with four sacks at UWSP. He now has a WIAC best 6.5 sacks this year.
- * UWRF freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel broke his own single game pass receptions record at UWSP. He caught 12 passes for 144 yards and two touchdowns - both covered 15 yards. He leads the WIAC in receptions (36) and receiving yards (474).
- * Junior quarterback Storm Harmon leads the WIAC in passing yards per game (257.0). He has already tied or broke three UWRF passing records this year. Against Pacific Lutheran he was 26-49 which set records for completions and attempts in a game. Against Hope he threw four touchdown passes which tied the school record. He has thrown for 1,028 yards this season and the Falcon record is 1,506.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 96-85-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 7-11 against UWW.

- * After Saturday's game at Whitewater the Falcons return to Ramer Field to host UW-Eau Claire at 1 p.m., on Oct. 13. The contest is the annual Homecoming, Hall of Fame and Shrine Game.

Stevens Point 45, River Falls 42

The Falcons put six touchdowns on the board but lost at UW-Stevens Point 45-42 on Saturday afternoon in the WIAC season opener.

The final definitive blow came from a 25-yard touchdown run with just 2:17 left in the fourth quarter by UWSP quarterback Jake Swank.

RF began the scoring in the first quarter on a 1-yard senior running back Nathan Anderson rush at the 9:26 mark. That score was set up when line-backer Bruce Baillargeon forced a fumble it was recovered by Ben Arata at the UWSP 39.

SP came right back as Kasey Morgan returned the ensuing kickoff 83 yards for a touchdown.

UWRF's Josh Grover returned the kickoff 43 yards to the UWSP 43 to set the Falcon offense up in great field position. Junior quarterback Storm Harmon found his favorite receiver, freshman Michael Zweifel, for a 15-yard touchdown strike on the next drive to take the lead back 14-7.

Senior defensive end Gregg Neumann, who finished with a school record four sacks, recovered a SP fumble with 1:12 left in the first quarter letting the RF offense set up shop at the SP 35 yard line. From there it took five plays for RF to punch it in; two of the pass were passes to Zweifel, including a 15-yard touchdown play for his second scoring reception of the day.

SP added a field goal and a touchdown, with seven seconds left before the half, to bring SP to within five. RF took a 21-16 lead into halftime.

RF saw their first half lead last only 2:04 as SP drove 73 yards on eight plays to take the lead 24-21. The touchdown came from a 33-yard rush by running back Mike Ferron. Ferron finished with a game-high 199 yards and two touchdowns.

Harmon led the Falcons back going 3-4 for 54 yards on the next drive, including an 18-yard touchdown pass to sophomore tight end Ryan Hansen. The RF defense held SP to a three-and-out on its next possession. On the ensuing RF possession Harmon, for the third consecutive week, threw an interception that was returned for a touchdown. Luke Frisch returned the pick 33 yards for the score to give UWSP a 31-28 lead with 8:37 to play in the third quarter.

RF converted a fourth-and-four from the SP-18 yard line on the next drive, keeping a 14-play, 68-yard drive alive that ended with a touchdown that gave RF a 35-31 lead going into the fourth quarter. Harmon scored the touchdown on a 2-yard run with 3:09 to play in the third quarter.

In a hectic fourth quarter SP took the lead, 38-35 with 10:23 to play when Ferron scored on a 4-yard run.

UWRF's Anderson scored his second touchdown of the day, on another 1-yard run, with 5:16 to play to give UWRF a 42-38 lead. That score was set up when senior corner Shane Hanson intercepted a UWSP pass and returned it 25 yards to the UWSP 25. It was Hanson's second interception of the year.

Swank scored what proved to be the winning points with just 2:17 to play. He scored on a 25-yard run that capped a 60-yard, eight-play drive.

RF got the ball back but gained only seven yards on their final drive attempt, turning the ball over on downs after they were unable to convert a fourth-and-eight from the RF 31.

The RF offense gained 406 yards on the day. Harmon was 21-43 for 218 yards, but did get intercepted for a touchdown for the third consecutive game. Anderson continued to tear through defenses gaining 141 yards and two touchdowns on the ground. And Zweifel had another big day catching 12 passes for 144 yards and two touchdowns. It was Anderson's 18th career 100+ rushing game. Zweifel set a record for receptions in a game with 12. He help the previous record, 10, set in games against Hope and Pacific Lutheran this year.

Baillargeon led the Falcon defense with nine tackles and Sean Wolf had six.

SP just proved to be too much. The Pointers scored on a kickoff return, an interception return, a pass and three rushes. SP also out-gained the Falcons on the ground 210 yards to 188.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRP and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRP in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRP students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRP graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRP for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRP graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

Whitewater 35, La Crosse 28

Whitewater only led in the game for sixty-one seconds, but it came at the right time as Jake Anderson scored from one yard out to bring UWW back from a 28-10 deficit as the Warhawks defeated UW-La Crosse 35-28 at Roger Haring Field at Memorial Stadium in La Crosse, Wisconsin Saturday.

Both teams are among the top ten in all three national Division III polls. Whitewater is now 3-1 overall and 2-0 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. UWL is 2-1, and 0-1 in league play.

Whitewater has won the last four meetings between the teams. U-W won 29-23 in La Crosse in 2005, 45-10 in last year's regular season meeting in Whitewater, and 24-21 in a NCAA III second round playoff game last November.

The victory extended Whitewater's win streak in WIAC play to 16 games, dating back to a loss to La Crosse in the final game of the 2004 season.

UWL drove seventy yards on the opening possession of the game, with Griffin Moe completing a two yard pass to Jason Wagner to put the Eagles up 7-0.

In the second quarter Eagle defensive back Matt Winney picked off a Danny Jones pass and returned it sixteen yards to the Whitewater seven yard line. On the next play Moe found Chris Johnson for the touchdown, putting La Crosse up 14-0 with 11:46 left in the half.

La Crosse threatened to extend the gap, moving the ball to the Whitewater 10 yard line, but after an incomplete pass, a running play that lost yardage, and a sack the Eagles missed a 40 yard field goal attempt.

Whitewater took possession of the ball at its own 23, then went 77 yards in seven plays, with Justin Beaver scoring from the one, to make it 14-7 with 3:08 left in the second quarter.

Moe and wideout Ted Everson brought the Eagles right back. UW-L went 60 yards in four plays, with Moe and Everson connecting for 37 yards on one pass and ending it with a 19 yard scoring strike to make it 21-7 La Crosse with just 0:34 left in the half.

UWW's Jeff Schebler kicked a 33 yard field goal with 9:57 remaining in the third to make it 21-10. Schebler's field goal, the twenty-fourth in his career, moved him in to ninth place in the WIAC record book.

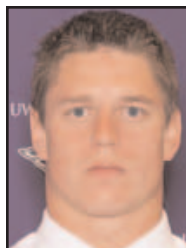
Again, La Crosse answered with a scoring drive. Again, it was Moe to Everson for the score, this time a 58 yarder at 7:57 to boost the margin back to 28-10 La Crosse.

Although no one in the stadium would have predicted it, that would be the end of the Eagles' scoring. And no one in the stadium would have predicted that Whitewater was about to score twenty-five points in the fourth quarter.

The comeback began, improbably, with La Crosse at the Whitewater 23 yard line. Moe's pass was intercepted by senior line-backer Jace Rindahl at the 23 and returned to the 27. Fourteen plays later, with 11:00 left in the game, Schebler booted on through from 41 yards out. La Crosse 28, Whitewater 13.

After forcing the Eagles to punt, Whitewater got the ball back at its own 24. And just as Moe and Everson had been a thorn in the Warhawks' side all day, the UW-W duo of Danny Jones and Matt Gifford took center stage. Jones hit Gifford with a 29 yard scoring pass with 6:01 remaining to close it to 28-20.

UW-L was on their 21 when Rindahl came up with another big play, forcing a fumble that UW-W defensive back Andy Murray recovered at the 25. Three running plays preceded another Jones to Gifford hookup, this time for 14 yards. La Crosse 28, Whitewater 26. UW-W elected to go for two, and Jones went back to the well, connecting with Gifford to knot the game at 28-28 with 3:55 left.

Lance Leipold

was a quarterback for the Warhawks in the mid-1980s and former Warhawk assistant coach. He was associate head coach and offensive coordinator for the University of Nebraska-Omaha since 2004.



Leipold, of Jefferson, played four years for the Warhawks (1983-1986). The 1984 team won the WIAC title, and the teams he played on were a combined 20-10-2.

He is still second all-time in the Warhawk record books for career pass attempts (647), third in yards (4277), fifth in completions (303) and tied for ninth with 27 touchdowns.

He is also among the top 10 in those same categories in the UWW records for a single season, all in his junior year in 1985. In a game against UW-River Falls in 1985 Leipold completed 37-57 for 494 yards -- all among the top 20 individual games in WIAC history. He was the team MVP in 1986, and was elected to the UW-W Athletics Hall of Fame in 2003.

Leipold's coaching career began where he played, at UWW. He coached quarterbacks in 1987 and wide receivers in 1988, helping both teams win WIAC (then WSUC) championships. After one year at Doane College in Nebraska, he returned to UW-W in 1990 to coach and work on a master's degree. He helped the Warhawks win another WIAC title while serving as Berezowitz's offensive coordinator. Leipold moved on to the University of Wisconsin-Madison for the 1991, '92 and '93 seasons, serving as a graduate assistant all three years, he worked with the offense. The 1993 Badgers won the Big Ten and the Rose Bowl, going 10-1-1. His first stint at Division II Nebraska-Omaha covered 1994-2000, where he was part of a staff that turned UNO from a 1-10 team (1994) to North Central Conference champions in 1996, 1998 and 2000. He was UNO's offensive coordinator in 2000. He moved to the University of Nebraska in 2001, serving as an administrative assistant the same year Cornhuskers won the national championship. In 2002 and 2003 Nebraska also went to bowl games with Leipold as a member of the staff. He returned to UN-Omaha in 2004 as the associate head coach and offensive coordinator, where he contributed to three consecutive 8-3 seasons and three straight conference championships.

Leipold takes over for his former coach Bob Berezowitz. Berezowitz announced his retirement before the 2006 season, ending a 22-year career. That span included 158 wins, third most in the history of the WIAC, a .680 winning percentage, nine conference championships, and five NCAA III playoff appearances.

In conference play, the Falcons are 25-18 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 28-38 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

Last Season

WHITEWATER 48, RIVER FALLS 16

The Falcon football team ended its season with a 48-16 loss to UW-Whitewater Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

Midway through the first quarter the Warhawks struck first going 60 yards in nine plays which was capped off by a 39-yard Jeff Schebler field goal to make the score 3-0 Whitewater.

RF responded two drives later going 66 yards and Josh Grover capped the drive off with a 23-yard touchdown catch from Jeremy Wolff. The drive ate up 3:45 off the game clock.

Much like they have all season long, the Warhawks answered back quickly with a three play 60-yard drive, which was capped off by a Justin Jacobs to Matt Gifford touchdown pass from 14 yards out to make the score 10-7 Whitewater after the first quarter.

On the third play of the second quarter, Wolff went back to pass and it was picked off by Tristan Borzick at the W 46-yard line and returned 26 yards to the RF 28-yard line. The Warhawks capitalized three plays later on a 27-yard Neil Mrkvicka touchdown catch from Jacobs to make the score 17-7.

After another RF three and out UWW set up shop at its own 12-yard line. Jacobs rumbled 34 yards out to the W 46-yard line. Six

plays later Jacobs finished off what he started scoring on a 2-yard plunge to make the score 24-7. The drive covered 88 yards and took 3:06 off the game clock.

After an RF turnover on downs the Warhawks started a drive at their own 43-yard line. UWW marched right down the field and scored seven plays later on Jacob Miller touchdown run from 1-yard out.

After another RF three and out Jovin Kroll punted the ball 41 yards and Mrkicka returned it nine yards, but fumbled the ball and Robby Nesvig returned it five yards down to the Whitewater 30. Aided on a 16-yard personal foul and the Falcons set up shop at the Warhawk 14. The Falcons could not move the ball so with only two seconds left in the half they settled for a 32-yard Spasimir Bodurski field goal to make the score 31-10 at recess.

To open up the second half UWW pounded the ball and drove 69 yards in 15 plays, which was capped off by a Schebler field goal from 29-yards out. The drive took 4:31.

After a Beau DeBruin fumble at the Falcon 40 yard line the Warhawks scored again. It took them only three plays to do so and Gifford caught his second touchdown pass of the game from Jacobs from 3-yards out to make the score 41-10 after the third quarter.
