## UW-River Falls vs. UW-Whitewater

Saturday, Oct. 11, 2008 - Ramer Field - Noon



### The Game

UW-River Falls hosts the defending NCAA Champion UW-Whitewater Warhawks on Saturday at Ramer Field. Kick off is set for noon. UWW holds a 28-21-2 advantage in the all-time series. Whitewater has won six straight games in the series, including a 38-12 decision in Whitewater in 2007. The last Falcon win was at UWW, 34-31, in 2001.

### Broadcasts/Webcasts/Stats

### The Coaches

UWRF's John O'Grady is in his 20th season with the Falcons. He got his 100th career win last weekend and is now 100-91-3 overall record at UWRF. He is 71-63-3 in WIAC games and is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and was the team's captain in 1975 and played linebacker. O'Grady was inducted into the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2008. He is 7-12 against UWW. Lance Leipold is in his second season at UWW. The Warhawks capped the 2007 season with the NCAA National Championship. Leipold, a 1986 graduate of UWW, is a near-perfect 18-1 in his career.

### The Falcons

The Falcons will be looking to win for the second week in a row when they host UWW on Saturday. UWRF has averaged about 32 points in its last three games. Last week the Falcons opened WIAC play with a 36-30 win at Ramer Field over previously unbeaten UW-Stevens Point. Quarterback Storm Harmon completed 26-33 passes for 241 yards and three touchdowns. He did not throw an interception. Sophomore wide receiver Michael Zweifel, who was named the WIAC Offensive Player of the Week, led the Falcons with 16 catches for 139 yards and two touchdowns. Tight end Patrick Houlton had his best game as a Falcon with seven catches for 66 yards and one score. Matt Pol-

lock led the Falcon ground game with 74 yards and one touchdown. Greg Klingelhutz, who was named the WIAC Special Teams Player of the Week, gave the Falcons a big boost with an 86-yard kickoff return for a touchdown. UWRF intercepted three passes - by senior Jamie Bisch, and freshmen Matt Guertin and Matt Gajewski.

### Falcon Notes

Sophomore wide receiver Michael Zweifel has caught at least one pass in every college game he has played in - now 14. He has caught 10 or more passes in eight contests. He has twice been limited to two receptions; in a 27-20 win over Eau Claire in 2007 and in a 22-6 loss at St. John's this year...RF has turned the ball over six times (one interception, five fumbles), while the RF defense has seven interceptions and one fumble recovery... The Falcon defense has recorded four sacks; the RF offense has allowed nine sacks. Harmon leads the WIAC in passing (196.2 yards per game) and Zweifel is tied for the lead in receptions (38) and receiving yards (419).

### The Warhawks

Whitewater, ranked No. 2 in the AFCA Coaches poll, is off to another great start with 4-0 overall and 2-0 WIAC records. UWW dominated UW-La Crosse last weekend in a 31-0 win, giving the Warhawks 23 straight WIAC victories. Levell Coppage leads UWW in rushing with 566 yards and eight touchdowns. He averages 5.1 yards per carry. He leads the WIAC in rushing yards and scoring. Jeff Donovan has completed 56-87 passes for 597 yards and two scores. He has been intercepted five times. Aaron Rusch leads UWW with 28 catches for 265 yards. The UWW defense is allowing just 7.5 points and 68 yards rushing a game. Jace Rindahl leads his team with 23 tackles. Rindahl and Jeremy Diebert both have two interceptions. UWW is a plus-four in turnover ratio.

The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in WIAC play.

The Falcons are 29-42 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play.
