- 3) Explore the possibility for creating a system for allotting points (credit) for student participation in such international themed programs/events, as part of meeting a student's international-experience requirement (this might include a new, non-course graduation requirement).
- 4) Pursue funding possibilities for expanding and promoting international film series on campus, ideally having international films be the focus of the film series one semester each academic year.
- 5) Expand and promote the UWRF Library's international CD/DVD collections.
