

## INSURANCE

The Uniform Statement of Responsibility, which each participant must sign, clearly identifies your acceptance of any risks that you may incur and your liability for them.

### Health Insurance

UW-System has negotiated a System-wide study abroad insurance plan (CISI-Cultural Insurance Services International) for all students studying abroad. All WIS students are required to have this coverage. The cost (\$37 per 30-day period) has been incorporated into the program fee.

The International Student Identity Card (ISIC) entitles you to various discounts and provides very minimal health coverage. The cost of the card is \$22 and is available in the Office of International Education/Programs.

### Travel, Baggage, and Trip Cancellation Insurance

These coverages may be sold separately or as a package. They usually provide reimbursement of non-refundable expenses due to withdrawal from your foreign study program, expenses incurred due to loss of luggage and personal property, and accidental injury or death while traveling. Some or all of these coverages may be provided by your travel agent, airline, or credit card company. Remember to consider your travel both to and from your program location and any periods of independent travel.
